### PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF THE STEELPOORT PUMPED STORAGE SCHEME AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE

Notice is hereby given in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations published in Government Notice No. R386 and No. R387 of 2006 in terms of Section 24 (5) of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No. 107 of 1998), that Eskom Holdings Limited intends carrying out the following activity, in order to meet growing electricity demands.

•The establishment of a pumped storage scheme and associated infrastructure in the Steelpoort area, in the Mpumalanga and Limpopo Provinces.

A pumped storage scheme supplies power during peak demand times and consumes surplus power during off-peak periods. The proposed scheme will consist of an upper and lower reservoir, an underground power house complex and associated waterways, as well as ancillary infrastructure such as roads, transmission lines and other associated infrastructure.

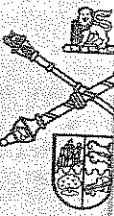
