







**ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROCESS**  
**PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF THE STEELPORT PUMPED STORAGE SCHEME**  
**AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE**

Notice is hereby given in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations published in Government Gazette No. 334 and No. 337 of 2010 in terms of Section 24 (1) of the National Environmental Management Act and in terms of 1996, and Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations No. 104 of 2010, that the following project is being assessed for its potential impacts on the environment, in order to avoid, minimize and compensate for any adverse effects.

- The establishment of a pumped storage scheme and associated infrastructure in the District of the Northern Cape and Northern Free State.

A pumped storage scheme involves power being stored in the form of water in an artificial reservoir during off-peak periods. The proposed scheme will consist of an upper dam, lower reservoir, an abutment power house complex and associated infrastructure, as well as pipeline infrastructure with its roads, transmission lines and other associated infrastructure.
