	park and that Eskom negotiate for the existing lines.
	Mr. Jacques Boonzaier used a map to explain the proposed route and the
	related alternatives in the area of Spitzkop. He asked the members of the
	council to help identify a route between the wetland near Spitzkop and farm
	identified for country estate village. (This is the area between the Kraalhoek farm

	consultation with the traditional council.

	negotiation processes
