# Tambaai skips gravel roads

The commuters who stay in Tambaai will be forced to walk longer distances to Tambarais because the drivers no longer be using gravel roads transporting them.

Explaining how they arrived at the decision, Hendrick Goleman, assistant manager, said:

"The gravel roads in the town-ship are in a bad condition and as it they damage our vehicles. Our cars will withstand bad roads but we can also afford to replace them so often."
