- A conveyor belt for the transportation of waste to the ash disposal site;
- Pollution control dams and water return channels;
- Services including electricity and water supply in the form of power lines, pipelines, and associated infrastructure; and
- Access and maintenance roads to the ash disposal facility.

The ash produced over the 60 year lifespan of the power station is estimated at approximately 460 million m³ and the proposed ash disposal facility will be around 40 to 60 m high at the end of its lifespan.

Notification letters and a background information document have been distributed and site notices were placed on 7 October 2011 to inform interested and affected parties of this environmental assessment processes and the approvals that are required. Based on the feedback received to date from interested and affected parties, a Draft Scoping Report has been prepared and will be made available for review.

Availability of Draft Scoping Report for public review from 18 January to 27 February 2012

In accordance with the EIA Regulations, the draft scoping report will be submitted to the competent authority for the environmental impact assessment and the waste management license, namely the national Department of Environment Affairs (DEA). Parallel to this submission, it will be made available for review by the public, relevant organs of state and other government departments for a 40 calendar day period. The public review period will be from **18 January to 27 February 2012**. Thereafter the report will be updated and resubmitted to the registered interested and affected parties and to the competent authority.
