I understand that my previous email did not get through to you. Hence, I am re-sending this message.

In light of the comments (attached) received by your department (DAFF) on the 14th February 2012, I would like to consolidate on our subsequent telephonic conversation the same day, most notably with respect to bullet point 2:

“The applicant must then furnish this office with a detailed rehabilitation implementation plan of the surrounding or the might be affected natural resources after or during the proposed activity”.

I would like to confirm that this point can be interpreted as follows: A rehabilitation implementation plan must be submitted to DAFF only **if** there are any impacts to the surrounding environment as a result of the proposed activity (either after or during) that have not been identified in the basic assessment process and addressed in the environmental management plan for the proposed development from which the DEA will issue a decision on environmental authorisation.

Kindly advise. Your soonest response will be much appreciated.
