I have reviewed the updated alignment map. It appears that ECPTA's concerns have been implemented and the proposed route now avoids the Baviaanskloof and associated reserves as well as the Honeyville cultural development close to Humansdorp.

I will be sending Tracey Steyn to one of the stakeholder meetings that will be held in the Jefferys Bay and Humansdorp areas. I would however like to request a separate meeting with the team when they are in the Eastern Cape where ECPTA can provide further inputs into the EIA specifically concerning biodiversity offsets for the Thyspunt area and the potential effects of power lines from the reactor site to the start of the power lines at the sub station.
