1 WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Nicolene Venter, the facilitator, thanked the attendees for attending the Feedback Meeting and provided Liesl Koch the opportunity to present the status of the proposed Thyspunt Transmission Lines Integration Project (TTLIP) to them.

3 PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

Liesl Koch informed the attendees that the purpose of the Feedback Meeting is to:

- provide an opportunity to seek any further clarity on the proposed project.

4 PROJECT OVERVIEW

Liesl Koch gave a brief overview as to why the proposed project is required and did not elaborate in detail as most stakeholders and I&APs have been part of the consultation process to date.

 The EIA process was put on hold towards the end of January 2010 due to financial reasons.
