A CHILD of three was among seven people who died in a car in a head-on collision with a truck between Robertson and Ashton last night.

Four men and two women had also died in the car, a Toyota Corolla, which had been travelling towards Robertson, provincial traffic spokesman

Xenophone Wentzel said. It appeared one of the vehicles involved in the collision had been trying to overtake two other vehicles.

Wentzel said the two survivors of the accident had been treated for shock and slight injuries. - Staff Writer

## Police to take action as firms battle 'huge curse' of false insurance claims

INSURANCE companies are having to battle the "huge curse" of people pretending to have been burgled and then falsely claiming insurance money.

And police officers have now warned they will take serious action against people who do this.

"The huge curse of this industry is people lodging false claims. It's a major problem and the worst case scenario is when people manufacture a burglary," Outsurance spokesman Trevor Devitt said yesterday.

He said "as the economy took a bit of a dive", the problem had increased.

Devitt declined to give figures but said the problem had reached such an extent that it was "enough to worry about".

If a claim was proved to be fraudulent, he said, it was rejected and the person's insurance was cancelled.

"In extreme cases we open a fraud docket with police," Devitt said.

According to the Mutual and Federal website, the company has created a specialist investigation unit because of "the escalation of fraudulent insurance claims". The Budget Insurance website said fraud cost the insurance industry "millions every year".

Yesterday police spokesman Andre Venter said in a few months officers in Wynberg had nabbed three residents

for lodging false complaints and he believed the problem was more widespread. "It's messing with our time, our crime statistics and hampering our services," he said.

"This is a serious problem and we will take serious action against people who do this. People shouldn't underestimate us... We won't tolerate the registering of false complaints and will oppose bail."

In one of the Wynberg cases, a resident reported to police that his two plasma screen televisions, a DVD player and a sound system had been stolen from his home. "Eventually he told police where he believed the stolen property had been handed in at a place in Woodstock," Venter said.

Officers tracked down a second-hand dealership where employees gave them a description of the person who sold them those items.

It turned out to be the complainant in the case and officers established that his home had never been burgled.

Venter said the man had already claimed from his insurance and was arrested on a perjury charge.

In the other two cases residents claimed to have been robbed of thousands of rands belonging to the companies they worked at.

It turned out both had stolen the money themselves.

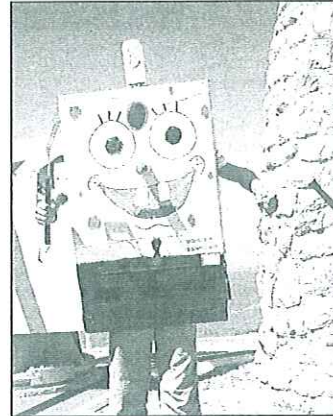

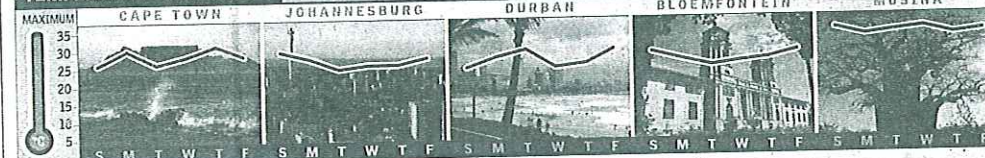

## Koeberg set for shutdowns

KOEBERG nuclear power station will be forced to shut down both reactors over the next three weeks to repair leaking pipes.

Eskom spokesman Tony Stott said maintenance would be carried out at power stations around the country earlier than usual to ensure a stable electricity supply for the World Cup.

Both units at the Koeberg nuclear power station in the Western Cape will undergo shutdowns to repair the rubber lining of the steel pipes used to carry sea water to cool some of the components inside the station.

Instead of fixing the problem during Koeberg's next refuelling outage, Stott said that they would shut down unit one over the long weekend to complete the repairs.

Unit two would then be shut down over the Easter weekend for similar repairs.

"This is not the system that cools down the reactor — that is an independent system," he said.

The long weekends were chosen because electricity demand was lower.

Stott said that he did not expect power shortages during that time. — Nashira Davids



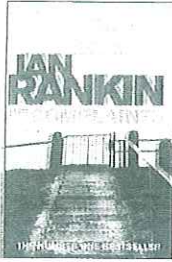

When that irascible Scottish Detective Inspector John Rebus retired in *Exit Music*, after 17 gripping thrillers, I wondered whether author Ian Rankin would create another character or a new series. Rebus was always going to be a hard act to follow but fans needn't worry, Malcom Fox, who makes his debut in *The Complaints*, is the new hero. He is almost the exact opposite of the charismatic Rebus, who enjoys his drink and tad street cred. Fox, on the other hand, has only been a teetotaler after a bout with alcoholism. He lives in a beige bachelor bungalow on



his own, still feels guilty after beating up his ex-wife, watches reruns of *Top Gear*, and while Rebus was a classic rock fundi, Fox's favourite radio station is one that plays birdsong.

Rankin has kept Edinburgh, the city he knows so well, as the backdrop for his new hero's adventures.

The year is 2009 and Scotland is in the grip of the recession. Buildings are half-completed and the poor and homeless are even more vulnerable.

Inspector Fox works in the Complaints and Conduct department, whose members are pariahs, because they investigate other cops for serious infractions: corruption and racism, for starters.

While the complaints team have finally

been able to compile enough evidence to make a case against Glen Heaton of the CID, who has been bending the rules for the past 11 years, Fox is given another job, to expose a cop, Jamie Breck, who is suspected of being a member of an internet paedophile ring.

However, there's no proof and Fox is ordered to get close to him to find it. But Fox has another problem, his sister Jude's abusive partner, Vince Faulkner, is found dead and she is being accused of his murder.

There are lots of questions: Is Breck a paedophile? Why is he being watched? Are Fox and Breck being set up? And by whom? And why? Why was Faulkner murdered? These disparate threads are brought together in Rankin's inimitable style.

It is a gripping read from page one and it will keep you reading and guessing late into the night. Here's a due thought: Follow the money.

It's white-knuckle stuff as *The Complaints* races to an explosive climax. Don't miss it.

EDEN District Mayor Leon Dorfling has called on tourism operators on the Garden Route not to inflate prices unnecessarily during the mid-year Fifa World Cup.

Dorfling said delegations visiting France, Denmark and Japan, whose national teams will be based in Knysna and George, found fans were concerned that the private sector was increasing prices unreasonably.

"I want to call on the local private sector to keep prices within reasonable limits. Apart from the influx of visitors to our region, the most important legacy will be the marketing that will remain for many years."

Dorfling said another concern was the perception of crime.

"The visit of our delegation to Denmark, France and Japan has con-

firmed there is indeed a misconception about crime and violence which is detrimental to our country and region's image... The fact is that our country has set aside R1.3-billion for safety and security during the World Cup."

Between 40 000 and 45 000 police will be deployed at stadiums, Fifa offices, transport points, fan-parks and training grounds.

Dorfling said despite low ticket sales and the fact that Europe and Asia were just emerging from the recession, the Eden District remained positive about the benefit of the World Cup for the region.

"As mayor, I'm satisfied with the progress we've made, although preparations will be rolled out faster closer to the tournament."

Hitchens, manager at the 46 000-seat stadium that will host eight World Cup matches.

... this the southern coastal towns that host the luxury hotels where Japan, France and Denmark will base their teams.

"Several farms have already shut down," said Stephan Gericke, chairman of the George Agricultural Association, which is seeking permission to expand reservoirs.


"The problem is to get approval to extend existing dams and build new ones," he said.

But weather officials say the only real solution for the shrinking water supply is flooding when the rainy season begins again in September.

The last big floods in the Eastern Cape were in 1981, and to a lesser extent in 2006.

Port Elizabeth weather office spokesman Garth Sampson said: "In the Eastern Cape, we don't have normal rainfall. We have too much rain or too little. The drought needs to be broken by a flood, but that will cause problems, too." - Sapa-AFP

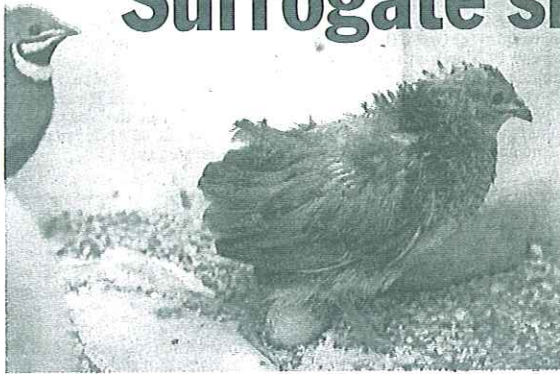

"BENGALESE finch on quails eggs" – No, it's not a creative recipe conjured up by a famous TV chef, but rather a mini surrogate project underway in a home in Ysterplaat.

Linda van der Nest (really, no pun intended) and her husband Corrie have been breeding finches for the last six months.

"The hobby started off with a couple of Zebra finches, then for my birthday Corrie bought me a male Bengalese finch," says Linda.

They put the new addition to the family in the cage with the Zebra finches.

"The birds did not get along. I then realised that the Bengalese was fighting with the breeding Zebras because he wanted to sit on the nest. "I came into the kitchen one morning and saw the tiny quail chick running around on the table next to the cage," Linda says with a nurturing smile.

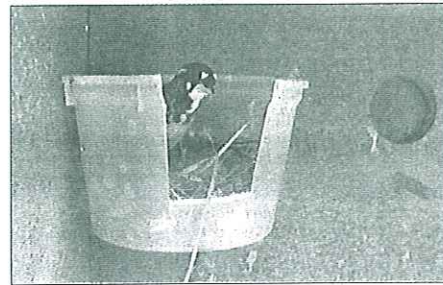
She adds that quails are ideal foster chicks as, like chickens, they can eat by themselves from the day they are born.

# This lift was not quite the real lift

TWO Table View women recently had the shock of their lives when they spent half an hour trapped in the lift shell of the lift at the Blaauwberg municipal building in Milnerton.

Jackie Kennedy and Alice Soll were visiting the Block A offices of the building, near the Paddocks, on Friday 5 March at about 10:00.

Mrs Soll is a senior citizen and chose to take the lift instead of climbing the stairs to the first floor.

A City staff member opened the glass door

to the lift and helped the women inside. It was only once the door was closed behind them and they started looking for buttons, that they realised that the lift was in fact above them.

Kennedy says she doesn't think the staff member realised what he was doing. "It's not his fault," she says.

He tried to help by pressing buttons on the outside of the lift, but soon disappeared.

Kennedy explains that the floor had the same carpeting as the rest of the building.

"It looks like you are getting into the lift," she says.

The two say other staff members started drawing closer to the lift, to see how they

could help. "It was something out of a Bruce Willis movie," says Kennedy.

A supervisor was called, but the women say he didn't seem to know what to do.

After half an hour, the fire services and paramedics arrived to help. The fire services broke open the lock of the glass door to let them out.

"As we got out, the lift came down very slowly," says Mrs Soll.

The two want to use their story to urge people to be more aware when using lifts.

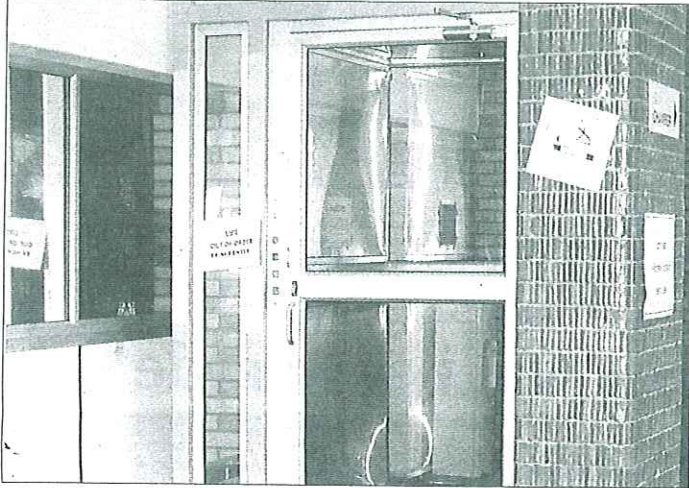
Gisela Kaiser, director of specialised technical services for the City says: "We are aware of the incident that happened on Friday 5 March, but do not know the identity of the person who allegedly helped the two women into

the lift or how they actually gained access to the lift."

When entering the municipal building, all visitors must sign an indemnity clause, but, as Kaiser explains: "The indemnity clause does not cover negligence on Council's behalf as per common law."

This means that if something had happened due to the Council not maintaining the lift in terms of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, they would be held liable, irrespective of the indemnity clause.

Kaiser says: "The interlocks were tested subsequent to the incident, and are such that when the lift is on top, the door cannot open via the normal button switches."
