

In the months, Nosandiso Maphungwana has had to rebuild her house three times after a fire.

She said she lost her belongings in a fire on December 26 in which more than 150 stacks were destroyed and more than 700 people were displaced.

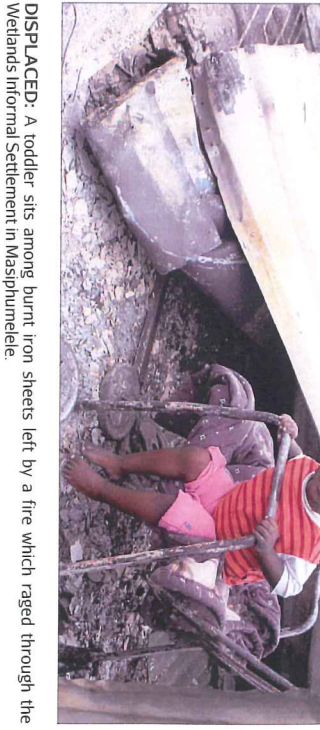

Lower carbon economy needed to help save planet

SOUTH AFRICA has to move towards a lower carbon economy – "whether you like it or not" – both because of international obligations and to save the planet from "catastrophic climate change", Trade and Industry Minister Roy Davies said yesterday.

Addressing business and industry representatives in Saldanha to report on the work being done to bring industrial development to the West Coast town, Davies said a move to a lower carbon economy could unlock a range of benefits in the form of green industries and green technology development.

He said indications were that Saldanha was well placed to become South Africa's "green" industrial development zone (IDZ), incorporating renewable energy power generation and a green technology manufacturing industry.

While there were many approaches from industrialists who wanted to bring renewable energy technology to South Africa, what his department was looking for were investors who would set up local manufacturing plants in green technology. This was to stimulate the industry locally and to cut the carbon footprint of overseas imports.

If investors wanted to import all their own components for the renewable energy, the government would

"sign a heavy tariff on it".

Davies said a pre-feasibility study had indicated that an IDZ at Saldanha would be "very valuable", where an investment of R15 billion could generate about the same amount of money once the project was up and running. A full feasibility study was under way, which should be completed by October.

Davies's department has been leading the work done on the South African Renewables Initiative, which aimed to draw on international climate funding for renewable energy production and the renewable energy manufacturing sector.

Davies said industrial sectors that Saldanha would be well placed to develop were:

- A beneficiation plant to turn the sand mined locally and shipped overseas from Saldanha in its raw state, into a rare minerals manufacturing plant that would provide a monetary high return and create 2 800 permanent jobs;
- Wind and photovoltaic energy plants, and local industries to manufacture some of the components needed for these technologies;
- Mariculture, particularly abalone farming;
- The servicing of offshore gas and oil rigs;
- Boat-waluting, which was already a R2bn industry in South Africa, and could be expanded.

of the old faces have been omitted from the new election list.

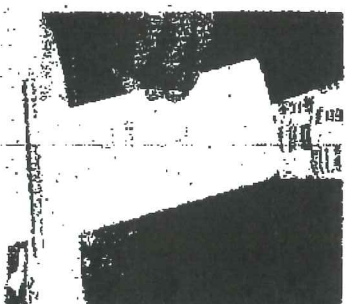
The DA is hoping their performance in the Western Cape rubs off.

A CAR tracking company is expecting "some serious debate" over a risky advert in today's Sunday Times.

Featuring a sketch of slain al-Qaeda leader Osama bin Laden, stolen vehicle recovery company Cartrack states: "It took the CIA 10 years. It could've taken us 10 minutes."

● Do you believe there is too much media freedom?

I do believe in media freedom, especially having evolved from that environment, but I also believe very strongly that along with the freedom comes the responsibility. The press and people in general should be more self regulatory and the world would be a better place.

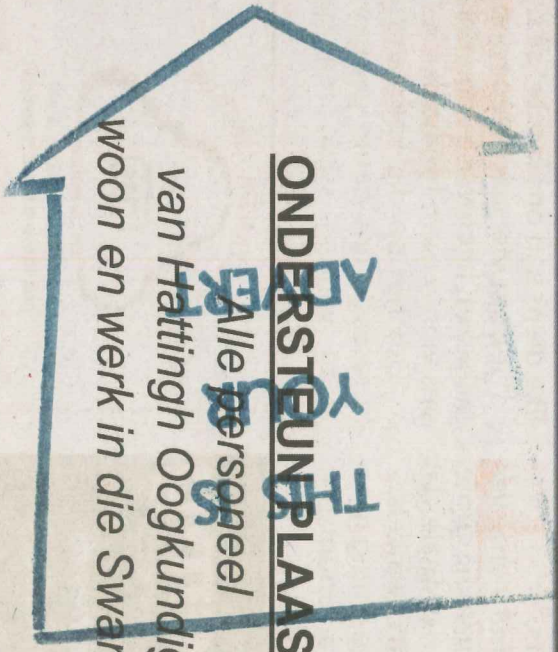

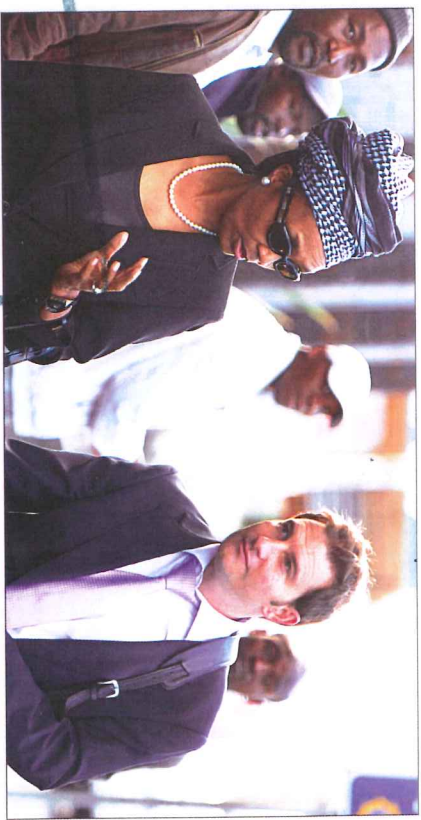

Space: different rules

The intricacies and complications associated with flying in a spacecraft were vividly described by world-renowned Russian cosmonaut and former Red Army test pilot, Valery Tokarev during his lecture at the Cape Peninsula University of Technology (CPURT) recently.

This lecture was part of celebrations across the world to commemorate man's first venture into space when cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin rocketed into space.

Tokarev demonstrated through videos he took in space during his past expeditions how different it was to do basic things such as eating, drinking water, and sleeping in space than on the ground.

Sleeping was one of the interesting subjects that he explained because due to zero gravity it did not matter in which position you slept.

He stressed the importance of exercise and concentration.

Tokarev, who was a guest of the South African National Space Agency (Sansa), said the

revery commemoration of the 50th anniversary of the first manned space flight by Yuri Gagarin marked a very important milestone for Russians, especially those who worked for the space agency.

"It's a symbol of our success and high level of engineering in the world," he told students and lecturers at CPURT's French South African Institute of Technology (F'Saite).

Yuri Gagarin became the first human being in outer space after his spacecraft completed an orbit of the Earth in April 1961. Tokarev, clad in his trademark blue space-suit said as a rule if you spent six months in space you needed six months on the ground to recover.

He stressed the importance of having to be in peak physical condition and shape when you go to outer space.

Asked how he felt when arriving on earth after his first space expedition he said he felt "very emotional". Tokarev said though they were scheduled to sleep for seven hours, five hours of sleep was enough for him per day.
