



Johann,

I believe Tony Butler's earlier invitation for constructive proposals for the protection of the spit dune was based on a genuine concern in the face of overwhelming evidence of the threat of a breach, previously shared with your readers: reports from coastal engineering experts, a time series of satellite images at constant elevation, and old-fashioned personal observations. Koos Vermaak has elected to ignore this evidence and his response to Tony's invitation is nothing more than a record of obstructionist activities

His only positive proposal is that we return to the methods of Leighton Hulett! It seems to have passed Dr Vermaak by that the sea no longer behaves as it did 50 years ago: the sea level is rising and storms have become more violent.

No amount of obfuscation is going to make this problem go away, and when (not if) the inevitable happens and the spit dune is breached, R10000 will look like small change compared to the damage canal owners will suffer. Unfortunately, there are none so blind as those that will not see.




