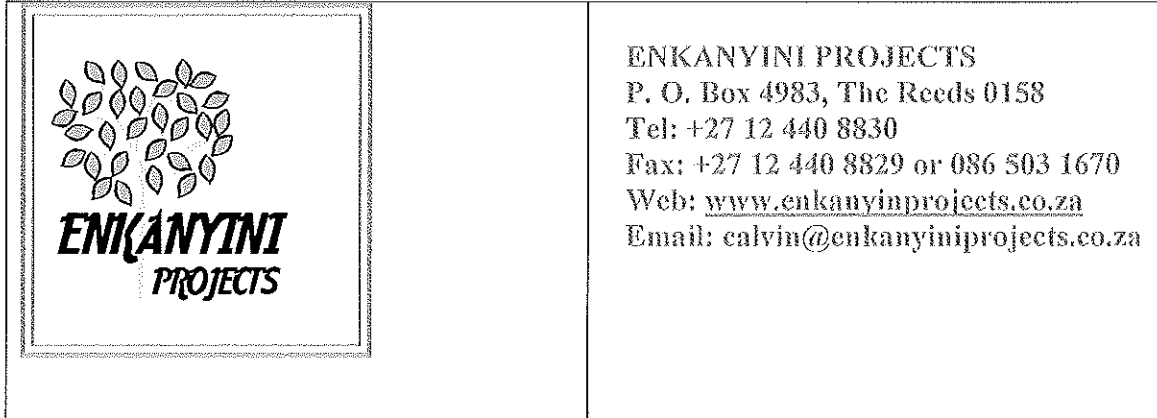
PAULPUTS SUBSTATION UPGRADE, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE
