## Full Volume Siren Test

### 1 March 2017

A full volume siren test of the Koeberg Public Warning System will be conducted in Atlantis, Duynfontein, Melkbosstrand, Van Riebeeckstrand, Philadelphia, Bloubergstrand, Bloubergstrand, West Beach, Sunningdale, Parklands, Robben Island and the farms surrounding Koeberg Nuclear Power Station between **10:00 and 12:00** on the morning of **Wednesday, 1 March 2017**.

No action needs to be taken by members of the public as this is only a test. However, as a precaution, please ensure that your pets are indoors or are in an area where they cannot escape (due to the volume and the sound of the wailing test tone, dogs have been known to run away from their homes). Remember to switch off your radio and television in order to hear the Public Address announcements informing you about the test. Please do not panic as this is only a test. We appreciate your co-operation.

If necessary, individual sirens may be re-tested on **Thursday, 2 March**, and **Friday, 3 March 2017**, for maintenance purposes. Note that the sirens form part of the Koeberg Emergency Plan and must be in working order.
