Background

Eskom's Integrated Strategic Electricity Planning (ISEP) process, which has been informed and guided by national policies and plans, has identified long-term options regarding both the supply and demand sides of electricity provision in South Africa. The latest ISEP plan (June 2003) has identified the need for increased electricity supply by the year 2010. While various alternative renewable electricity generation options are continually being investigated, coal is still the main fuel source in South Africa. According to the plan, coal-fired power stations will be required for generation capacity expansion during the next 20 years.

As part of the increased electricity supply plan, Eskom is considering a coal-fired power station and associated infrastructure in the area to the west of Witbank in Mpumalanga Province.

This proposed activity requires authorisation from the national environmental authority, viz. the Department of Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEAT) via the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process outlined in Regulation 1183, under Section 26 of the Environment Conservation Act (73 of 1989). Eskom has appointed Ninham Shand Consulting Services to assist them in complying with these legal requirements.
