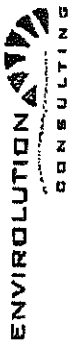

Dear Netisha Chetty,

I am Chairman of the Waterberg Nature Conservancy in the Waterberg Mountains in Limpopo Province. This letter is not commenting on Eskom's proposed general waste landfill site, but rather to the use of the name Waterberg. Let me explain.

Your notice in The Star of 30 January 2009 says "... as well as from two proposed future power stations in the Waterberg area."

The Waterberg Mountains benefit from many features, including the name itself. To those of us who live here, the very words conjure up all that we appreciate about the region - the bio-diversity, the environment, the vistas, the game, the watercourses, even the remoteness from urban centres. Those who operate

tourist establishments benefit from the natural branding; the rest of us are simply delighted with our good fortune.

When Eskom (and Sasol, Resource Generation, and so many others) uses the name Waterberg to identify its projects, you are detracting from the Waterberg's positive image. I realize that Envirolution and Eskom are simply looking for a convenient way to identify the project and location, but you are inadvertently joining others in destroying a valued name. I am well aware that the Waterberg Coalfields is a known and accepted geological place, so let that remain as a name.

Some tourist destinations abuse the name to reap good will by association, but mining and energy project locations should be identified accurately and clearly. The Waterberg name doesn't even give a good idea of where your project is located.

Eskom's Matimba and Medupi power stations are not in the Waterberg Mountains, nor are they in the Waterberg Biosphere Reserve. Yes, they are in the Waterberg District Municipality, but the Municipality is a very large area, extending well northeast of Lephalale, well south of Bela-Bela and well east of Modimolle.

Calling it in the Waterberg area is too casually done. I suggest you consider calling the area the Limpopo Western Bushveld, or Western Limpopo Bushveld or Western Limpopo.

Or, you could use the farm name where the landfill and hazardous waste facility is located, and say in or near Lephalale. With not much imagination, you can find accurate and easy names for all of Eskom's work in Limpopo Province.

You can see where I am coming from. The misuse of the Waterberg name already chips away at its positive image and value. Imagine in 20 years time when people hear the word Waterberg, they'll think of mining and industry and landfills and hazardous waste rather than nature. I'm sure Envirolution Consulting wouldn't want that, would you? I have made these points to Eskom directly, to other Eskom consulting firms, to Sasol, and to several mining companies. Envirolution has an opportunity to abandon the use of the Waterberg and to communicate all of this to your Eskom clients. Please do so.

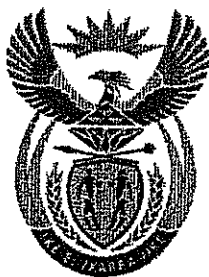



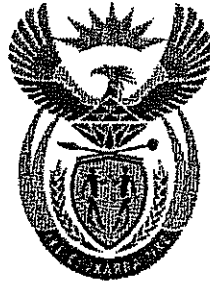
