This report (version 1) captures the issues raised by stakeholders during the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process as well as the application process for a waste license for the expansion and licensing of the waste disposal site at the Tutuka Power Station, near Standerton, in Mpumalanga.

As part of the announcement, a Background Information Document (BID), with a comment and registration sheet was posted and distributed by hand on 26 August 2009. An advertisement was placed in various newspapers as well as site notices put up in the area of the proposed development during the last week of August 2009. Several stakeholders responded to the invitation to raise their concerns and the table below represents those comments.

An Open House Session and Public Meeting were held on 18 November 2009 at the community hall at Thuthukani Village to present the findings of the Scoping Phase. Issues raised at the meeting were captured in this report, which was available for comment from 11 November to 10 December 2009.

This report will be updated as the EIA unfolds.
