AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 20 APRIL 2015 FOR THE PROPOSED AMANDLA AND KWAGGAFONTEIN SUBSTATIONS WITHIN THE ELIAS MOTSOLEDI AND THE THEMBISILE HANI LOCAL MUNICIPALITIES IN LIMPOPO AND MPUMALANGA PROVINCES.

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) dated 20 April 2015, as amended, for the abovementioned project, your application for amendment to the EA received by this Department on 06 March 2020 and the acknowledgement letter thereto dated 16 March 2020, refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended, has decided to amend the EA dated, 20 April 2015, as follows:

Amendment 1: Extension of the validity period

The activity must commence within a period of five (5) years from the date of expiry of the EA issued on 20 April 2015 (i.e. commence by 20 April 2025). If commencement of the activity does not occur within that period, the environmental authorisation lapses and a new application for environmental authorisation must be made in order for the activity to be undertaken.

The reason for the extension of the validity period of the EA by an additional 5 years are due to financial constraints.

This letter must be read in conjunction with the Environmental Authorisation dated 20 April 2015, as amended.

In terms of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No 3 of 2000), you are entitled to the right to fair, lawful and reasonable administrative action; and to written reasons for administrative action that affects you negatively. Further your attention is drawn to the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act no. 4 of 2013) which stipulate that the Department should conduct itself in a responsible manner when collecting, processing, storing and sharing an individual or another entity's personal information by holding the Department accountable should the Department abuse or compromise your personal information in any way.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended (the EIA Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's decision as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014), which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. Kindly include a copy of this document (National Appeal Regulations, 2014) with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties in this matter.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
