NOTICE OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED DECOMMISSIONING OF A WASTE ROCK DUMP AT MATIMBA POWER STATION, LEPHALALE, LIMPOPO PROVINCE

Matimba Power Station is situated approximately 15 km northwest from the town of Lephalale in Limpopo Province. The Rock Dump located on the site is currently not in use; therefore Matimba Power Station requires it to be decommissioned. In order to comply with relevant legal requirements for decommissioning the rock dump will require a closure permit and associated Basic Assessment Process.

Notice is given in terms of Regulations published in Government Notice R. 718 in Government Gazette No. 32368 of 03 July 2009, under Section 19(1) of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No.59 of 2008), as amended, that Eskom Holdings Ltd proposes closure of existing rock waste dump site at Matimba power station in Lephalale, Limpopo Province, for the following listed activity:

Construction, expansion or decommissioning of facilities and associated structures and infrastructure
