Hope you had good time during Christmas and are ready for the task ahead. I am writing some few points I picked up at the meeting with Impala Platinum Mines representatives on 21 December 2009. Please add, correct or amend as you see fit:

- Date of Meeting 21 December 2009
- Attendance: Mr. Vilakazi (Eskom); Mr. Lepono (PBAI); Mr. Rudi Bingle (Impala); Mr. Vanghim Townsend (Impala): Mr. Mahlangu (Margen).
- Purpose: To Discuss the Eskom Project proposed for development near Ledig (Mogwase/ Ngwedi Project)
- Maps were presented and the discussion points are as follows:
 - o Site C might affect the location of 18 Shaft on the farm Goedgedacht.

• Site C & D are acceptable to Impala Mines but it must be realized that RBA must be involved in the consultation process for this because they must agree to the servitude through their properties.

• The mine is considering sinking a shaft near site C and though this site is considered an obstacle for the development of the mine, the mine will, however, still need mere electricity supply for this shaft.

• What is the timing in terms of commissioning the new Mogwase/Ngwedi substation in the area? [It is envisaged that the new substation will start working in 2012. Eskom intends to build the substation to have the capacity of 12 feeder bays. Only 6 feeder bays will be used in 2012].

Impala is considering taking 88kV distribution line from Ararat to the mine properties.
 The mine will be happy to source 132kV lines from Mogwase/Ngwedi. If this is possible the 88kV line will be dropped.

 It was proposed that a meeting that will involve RBA be arranged for the week of 11 – 15 January 2010.

This email is meant to circulate the minutes of a meeting held on 15 January 2010 with Impala Platinum Mines. Your comment, addition or correction will be appreciated. The minutes are recorded as follows: **Date:** 15 January 2010

Attendance: Mr. Rudi Bingle and Mr. Coenie Pretorius (Impala Platinum Mines); Mr. Ernie Kemm (Royal Bafokleng Administration); Mr. Sebenzile Vilakazi (Eskom Tx); Mr. Tsepo Lepono (PBAI); Mr. Moses Mahlangu (Margen).

Purpose: Follow-up meeting as agreed on 21 December 2009. It was agreed that a meeting be held to discuss the Mogwase (Ngwedi) Project in the presence of **RBA** representatives.

Points Discussed: Maps were used to explain the alternative sites for the proposed substation and turnins lines. It was explained that

- Sites A; E; B & D1 have been taken out during the consultation with other
- Sites C & D will be taken further for detailed investigation during the EIA Phase
- Mr. Pretorius indicated though the two sites (C & D) are acceptable but it seems like site C will result in new lines coming out of it impacting on future developments of the mine.
- Impala Platinum Mines will prefer to see the substation indicated as site C being shifted to north of the railway line
- Ms Beater will be requested to send the coordinates of bend points close Rhenosterfontein 86JQ.
- Generally all parties (Impala Platinum Mines & RBA) accepted **site C** for detailed investigation
- It was mentioned that more sites will be investigated on farms Mahobieskraal & Palmietfontein.
