5. This notice must be submitted to the Department at the postal address given below or by delivery thereof to the Registry Office of the Department. Should the notice not be submitted to the correct addresses given below this may result in unnecessary delays.

Should an applicant and not the Environmental Assessment Practitioner complete this notice then an application for exemption from the requirement that the notice of intent be prepared and submitted by an Environmental Assessment Practitioner must be made by completing the relevant section below.

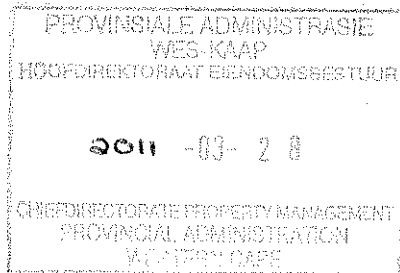
