NOTIFICATION TO THE LICENSING AUTHORITY- MONTHLY EMISSIONS REPORTS- May 2020 - June 2020. (MSUKALIGWA/ESKOM H SOC Ltd/CPS/0012/2019/F03).

Camden Power Station was issued with an Atmospheric Emissions License (ref: Msukaligwa/Eskom H SOC Ltd/CPS/0012/2019/F03) on the 25 April 2019 in terms of section 41 (1) of the National Environmental: Air Quality Act, 2004 (Act 39 of 2004), in respect of Listed Activity Category 1: sub category 1.1; Category 2: subcategory 2.4; Category 5: sub category 5.1.

In terms of condition 7.4 of the Atmospheric Emissions License (AEL) (MSUKALIGWA/ESKOM H SOC Ltd/CPS/0012/2019/F03)), Camden Power station is obliged to comply with point source emissions monitoring and reporting requirements.

Camden Power Station would like to notify the licensing authority that the Units operations have been ceased temporarily toward the end of April 2020 due to ashing capacity constraints. With the Units not operational, there has been no combustion process taking place, and as a result there was no point source emissions generated and no raw materials burnt (Coal and Fuel) as specified in the emissions license.

With the above indication, the emissions reports for both May and June 2020 will not be generated. The facility is expected to resume operations from the beginning of July 2020 after the ashing space is created.

Camden Power Station remains committed in compliance to all the license conditions and any other legislative requirements related to its operations.
