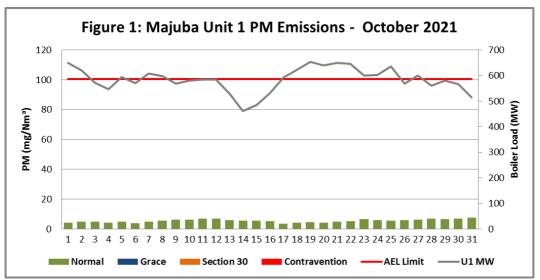


Figure 1. Particulate Matter emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 1.

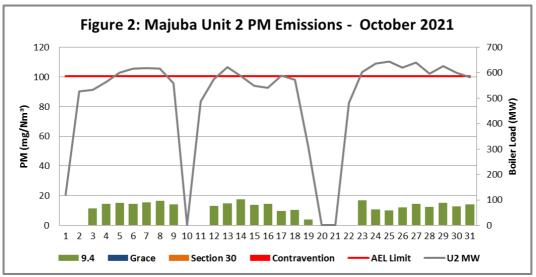


Figure 2. Particulate Matter emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 2.

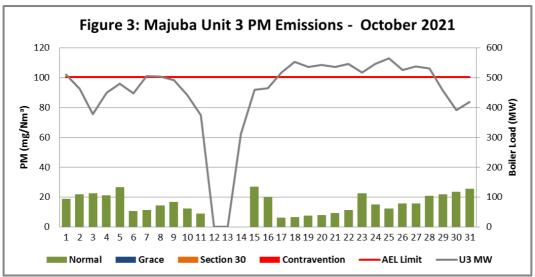


Figure 3. Particulate Matter emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 3.

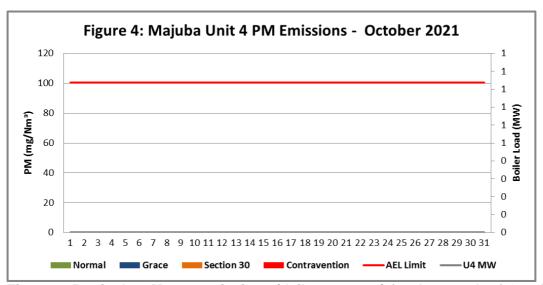


Figure 4. Particulate Matter emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 4.

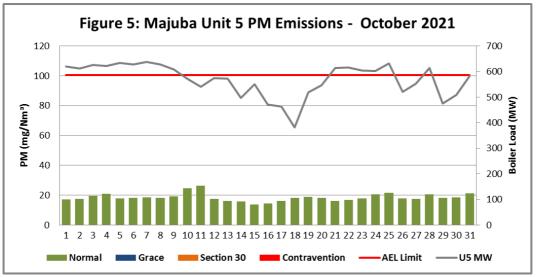


Figure 5. Particulate Matter emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 5.

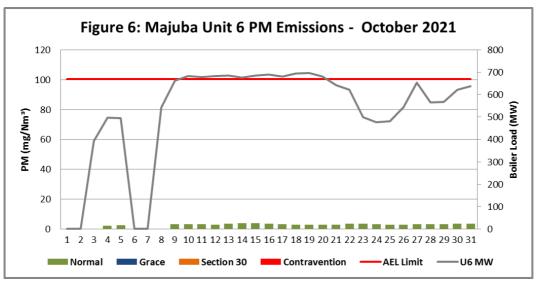


Figure 6. Particulate Matter emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 6.

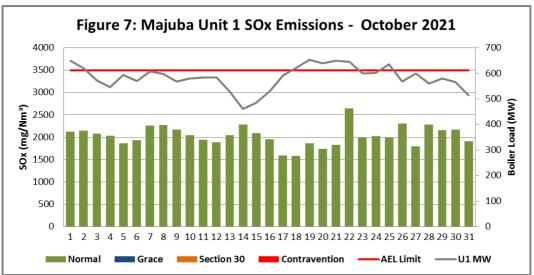


Figure 7. SOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 1.

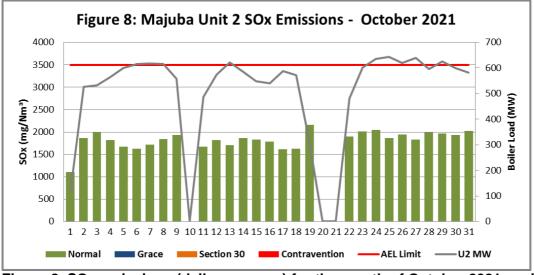


Figure 8. SOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 2.

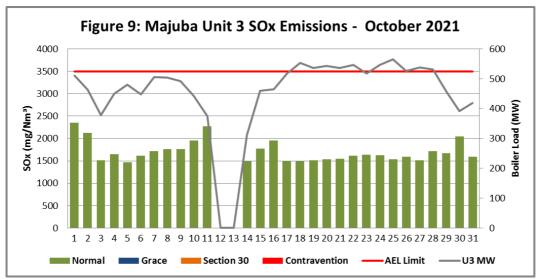


Figure 9. SOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 3.

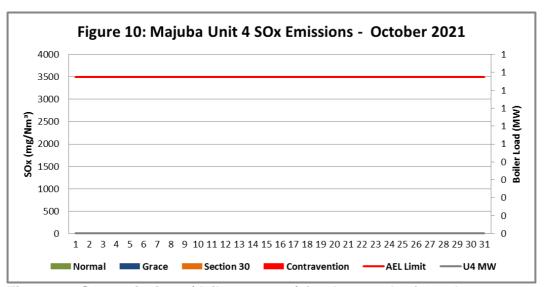


Figure 10. SOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 4.

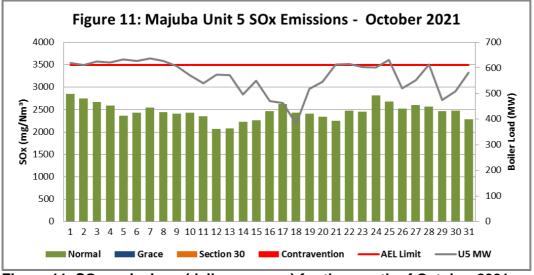


Figure 11. SOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 5.

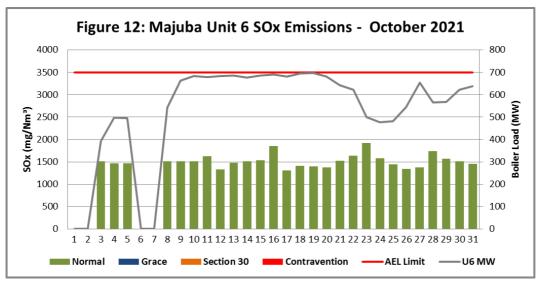


Figure 12. SOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 6.

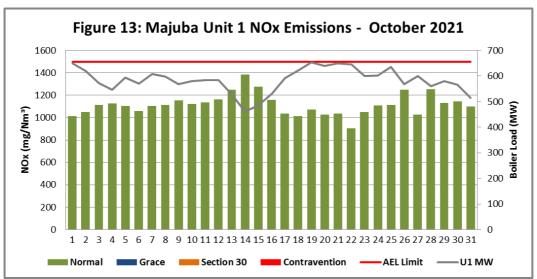


Figure 13. NOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 1.

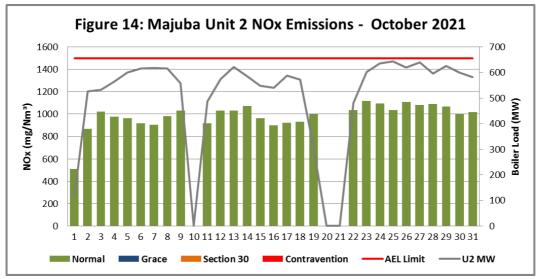


Figure 14. NOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 2.

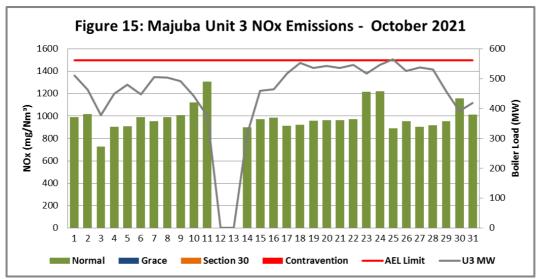


Figure 15. NOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 3.

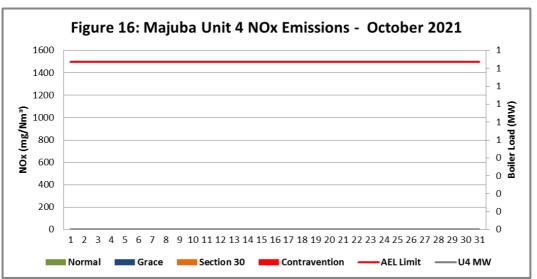


Figure 16. NOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 4

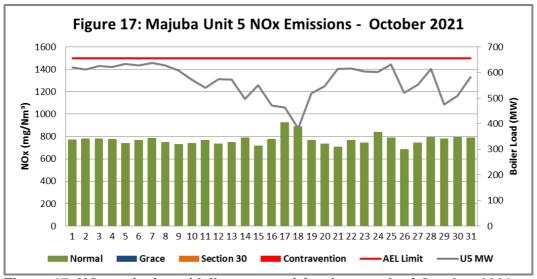


Figure 17. NOx emissions (daily averages) for the month of October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 5

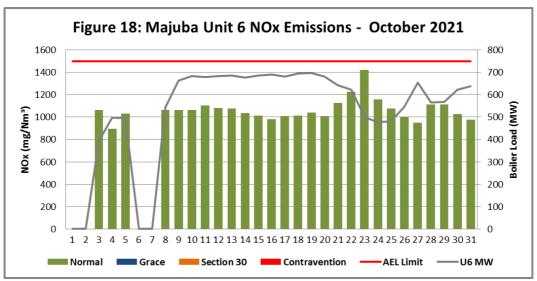


Figure 18. NOx emissions (daily averages) for the month October 2021 against emission limit for Unit 6

Correlation curves for Units 1 and 2 are still valid, however both Units were re-bagged and as a result new correlation tests are required. Unit 2 correlation tests started on 10 November 2021. Unit 4 correlation curves expired on 28 September 2021, however the unit remains on outage. New tests for Unit 4 are planned for when the Unit returns from outage. Unit 6 correlation curves expired on 28 October 2021 and new tests were completed on 02 November 2021. The correlation tests report for Unit 6 is outstanding.
