


Figure 1: PM emissions for the month of June 2024 against emission limit for the North Stack. The PMs Limit is 125 mg/Nm3. Monthly average was 170.6 mg/Nm3.




Figure 2: PM emissions for the month of June 2024 against emission limit for the South Stack. The PMs Limit is 125 mg/Nm3. Monthly average was 1 195.3 mg/Nm3.




Figure 3. SO₂ emissions for the month of June 2024 against emission limit for the North Stack. The SOx Limit is 3500mg/Nm3. Monthly average was 2 675.9 mg/Nm3.




Figure 4. SO₂ emissions for the month of June 2024 against emission limit for the South Stack. The SOx Limit is 3500mg/Nm3. Monthly average was 1 998.2 mg/Nm3.




Figure 5. NO₂ emissions for the month of June 2024 against emission limit for the North Stack. The NOx Limit is 1600mg/Nm3. Monthly average was 1 131.8 mg/Nm3.




Figure 6. NO₂ emissions for the month of June 2024 against emission limit for the South Stack. The NOx Limit is 1600mg/Nm3. Monthly average was 1 110.1 mg/Nm3.

General

The particulate matter (PM10) emissions on the North Common Stack exceeded the **monthly limit**; on average emissions figure of **170.6 mg/Nm**³ while South Common Stack also exceeded the **monthly limit** on the recorded PM10 monthly average figure of **1 195.3 mg/Nm**³. The gaseous (NOx & SOx) emissions on the North and South common Stacks were within the **daily limit** during the month of June 2024; refer to graphs above.
