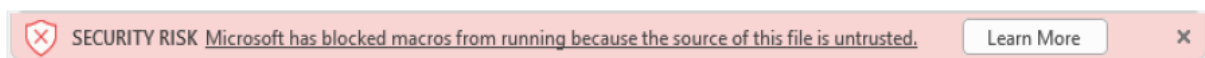
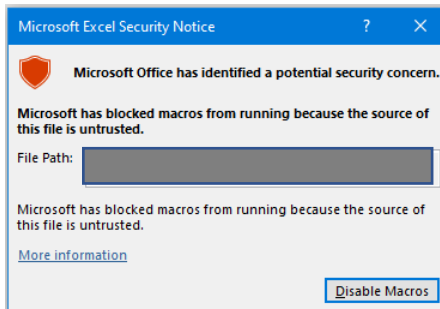


Macros from the internet are blocked by default in MS Office

VBA macros are a common way for malicious actors to gain access to deploy malware and ransomware. Therefore, to help improve security in Office, the default behaviour of Office applications is to block macros in files from the internet.



Steps to take to allow VBA macros to run in files that you trust

How you allow VBA macros to run in files that you trust depends on where those files are located or the type of file.

Scenario	Possible approach to take
Individual files	Select the Unblock checkbox on the General tab of the Properties dialog for the file

Remove Mark of the Web from a file

To unblock macros in a file, like one from the internet or an email attachment, remove the Mark of the Web on your local device. To remove, right-click on the file, choose Properties, and then select the Unblock checkbox on the General tab.
