

- Active Consumed Energy: The total energy delivered to an off-taker, measured during peak, standard, and off-peak periods each month at the off-taker's point of delivery.
- Active energy charges: The charges associated with the electrical energy supplied and delivered by the licensee and consumed by the off-taker
- **Buyer:** A third-party purchaser of the Wheeled Energy that concludes a Power Purchase Agreement with the Seller, which can be a: (a) Distributor (b) Trader (c) Corporate Entity (d) or an Off-taker, as may be applicable.
- Claimant: The entity that submits the wheeling energy refund to Eskom monthly. The claimant can be the Trader, the Buyer, or the Corporate entity.
- Corporate Entity: A juristic person (as defined in the Companies Act, 2008 (Act No. 71 of 2008) that purchases wheeled energy but is not a trader or a licensee.
- Connection and Use-of-Systems Agreement: The agreement between a generator and the network service provider for the connection to and/or use of the network, including for the export of the wheeled energy
- Electrical supply agreement: The agreement between a load and a licensee for the connection to and/or use of the network, including any purchase of electrical energy from the licensee and capacity associated with the delivery of energy.
- **Eskom Wheeled Energy**: Energy measured by Eskom at each metering installation during designated Time-of-Use (TOU) periods—peak, standard, and off-peak.
- Eskom-Connected Off-taker(s): Off-takers connected directly to Eskom's grid where wheeled energy is delivered.
- Excess Energy: Energy produced by the generator that exceeds the consumption by the off-taker during the same Time-of-Use (TOU) period.
- **Generation Wheeling Tariff**: The rate applied for wheeling energy through Eskom's grid, calculated based on energy consumed or wheeled during TOU periods.
- **Good Standing**: A status indicating that all Eskom or municipal accounts are fully paid and up to date, ensuring eligibility for wheeling transactions.
- **Independent Power Producer (IPP)**: A third-party energy generator that supplies energy through a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) to an off-taker via Eskom's grid or municipal infrastructure.
- Managing agent: Entity acting on behalf of a buyer or buyers with the relevant proxy to claim monthly energy refunds for wheeled energy.
- **Metering Point**: The location where a meter is installed to record the energy consumed or generated, crucial for energy tracking in wheeling transactions.
- Municipal-Connected Off-taker(s): Off-takers connected to a municipal grid that receive wheeled energy on behalf of the buyer.
- **Municipal Wheeled Energy**: Energy measured at municipal-connected off-taker installations during TOU periods, supplied by the buyer and transported through Eskom's infrastructure.
- **NERSA**: The National Energy Regulator of South Africa, being a regulatory authority established in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004) or its successor in title.
- Network service provider or NSP: The licensee who owns and operates the applicable Network
- Notified Maximum Demand (NMD): The maximum level of demand (in kVA or kW) expected from a
 customer, influencing wheeling tariffs.
- Off-taker(s): Entities receiving wheeled energy, whether they are Eskom-connected or municipal-connected.
- **Power Purchase Agreement (PPA)**: An agreement between a generator and a buyer for the sale and purchase of energy. .
- **Refund Adjustment**: A credit provided to the off-taker based on the Wheeled Energy Refund (WER) calculation, applied monthly after verification and approval by Eskom.
- **Smart Meter**: A programmable meter that records Time-of-Use data and supports remote data collection, essential for accurate energy tracking and settlements in wheeling.

- **Trader**: A commercial entity that buys and sells energy on behalf of others, often acting as an intermediary in the energy market.
- **Transactional Account**: An account set up to track energy transactions in the wheeling process, aggregating consumption data for billing and refunds.
- **Utility Account**: An account that records energy consumption, billed amounts and payments received for the supply of electricity.
- **Wheeled Energy**: The electricity generated by an IPP and transported to off-takers via Eskom's or a municipal grid.
- Wheeled Energy Refund (WER): The monetary refund provided for wheeled energy, calculated using Eskom's Generation Wheeling Tariffs and TOU data.
