

Eskom has received an enquiry from Eksteen & Le Roux Electrical Engineers for a residential development in the Brakpan/Boksburg area. The development is known as "Windmill Park Mega Project" and will consist of 11 000 units – 27.5MVA



Eskom is currently supplying the existing customer on a rural 11kV network and will continue to supply the area.

Eskom will contest if CoE wants to supply this development.
