APPROVAL OF THE FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (EMPR) AND LAYOUT PLAN FOR THE 320MWH SKAAPVLEI SUBSTATION BATTERY STORAGE FACILITY, MATZIKAMMA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the above application by this Department on 10 February 2020 and the final EMPr and layout plan received by the Department on 15 November 2022 refer.

The final EMPr and layout plan was submitted to fulfil the requirements of Conditions 13, 14, 15 and 31 of the EA dated 10 February 2020 which stated that:

Condition13:

"A copy of the final site layout map must be made available for comments by registered Interested and Affected Parties and the holder of this environmental authorisation must consider such comments. Once amended, the final development layout map must be submitted to the Department for written approval prior to commencement of the activity. All available biodiversity information must be used in the finalisation of the layout map. Existing infrastructure must be used as far as possible e.g. roads. The layout map must indicate the following:...."

Condition14:

"The Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) submitted as part of the BAR is not approved and must be amended to include measures as dictated by the final site lay-out map and the provisions of this environmental authorisation. The EMPr must be made available for comments by registered Interested and Affected Parties and the holder of this environmental authorisation must consider such comments. Once amended, the final EMPr must be submitted to the Department for written approval prior to commencement of the activity. Once approved the EMPr must be implemented and adhered to."

Condition15:

- The specific risk and management plans which is applicable to the impacts associated to the preferred 15.2 technology/technology mix.
- All recommendations and mitigation measures recorded in the BAR and the specialist studies 15.3 conducted.
- The final preferred layout map. 15.4
- An environmental sensitivity map indicating environmental sensitivity areas and features identified 15.5 during the assessment process."

Condition 31:

"The holder of the EA must decide on the preferred technology or technology mixture and inform this Department prior to commencement of construction."

This Department has evaluated the final EMPr (dated September 2022, prepared by SRK Consulting) and final Site Layout Plan (Eskom Skaapvlei BESS Project, dated 20 September 2022). It is this Department's opinion that the revised EMPr (dated September 2022, prepared by SRK Consulting) which includes the final Site Layout Plan complies and fulfils the requirements of Conditions 13, 14, 15 and 31 of the EA dated 10 February 2020. The final EMPr addresses possible impacts associated with the construction and operational phases of the authorised project. Therefore, the final EMPr and Layout Plan is hereby approved.

This EMPr approval must be read in conjunction with all the conditions contained within the abovementioned EA dated 10 February 2020. This EMPr should be regarded as a 'living document', which may be amended from time to time as and when the need arises.

In terms of Regulation 36. (1) & (2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended, the following is drawn to your attention:

- Regulation 36(1), "where an amendment is required to the impact management actions of an EMPr, such 1. amendments may immediately be effected by the holder and reflected in the next environmental audit report submitted as contemplated in the environmental authorisation and regulation 34. In terms of Regulation 36(1), an amendment to an impact management action, which does not result in the amendment of the impact management outcomes of the EMPr, may therefore be immediately effected by the holder, provided that such is reflected in the next environmental audit report as per Regulation 36(1).
- Regulation 36(2), "where an amendment to the impact management outcomes of an EMPr is required before an audit is required in terms of the environmental authorisation, an EMPr may be amended on application by the holder of the EA". This process also requires a public participation process per Regulation 37(2), as well as submission of the amended EMPr to the Competent Authority for comment and approval.


