COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT FOR THE PROPOSED ESKOM DAGBREEK BYPASS PROJECT SITUATED WITHIN THE WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

The draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR) received by this Department on 31 July 2017 and the application form received by this Department on 31 July 2017, refers.

This Department has the following comments on the above-mentioned application:

- a. Please ensure that all relevant listed activities are applied for, are specific and that it can be linked to the development activity as described in the project description.
- b. The EAP managing the application must provide a full description of the process followed during public participation process in terms Appendix 1 (3) (1) (h) (ii) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (2014), as amended. This must be included in the final BAR.
- c. Please be advised that the EMPr is not a generic document and must incorporate a good quality final layout plan. Further the EMPr must comply with Appendix 4 of the EIA Regulations 2014, as amended.
- d. Please ensure that all issues raised and comments received during the circulation of the draft BAR from registered I&APs and organs of state which have jurisdiction in respect of the proposed activity including comments from this Department are adequately addressed in the final BAR.
- e. Proof of correspondence with the various stakeholders must be included in the final BAR. Should you be unable to obtain comments, proof should be submitted to the Department of the attempts that were made to obtain comments.
- f. The Public Participation Process must be conducted in terms of Regulation 39, 40 41, 42, 43 & 44 of the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended.
- g. Please also ensure that the BAR includes the period for which the environmental authorisation is required and the date on which the activity will be concluded as per the Appendix 1 (3) (1) (q) of EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended.
- h. The submitted draft BAR does not include an undertaking under oath or affirmation by EAP. You are therefore required to include an <u>undertaking under oath or affirmation (administered by a Commissioner of Oaths)</u> as per Appendix 1 (3) (r) of the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended, which states that the BAR must include:

"An undertaking under oath or affirmation by the EAP in relation to:

- (i) the correctness of the information provided in the reports;
- (ii) the inclusion of comments and inputs from stakeholders and I&APs;
- (iii) the inclusion of inputs and recommendations from the specialist reports where relevant; and
- (iv) any information provided by the EAP to interested and affected parties and any responses by the EAP to comments or inputs made by interested and affected parties".

General

You are reminded to comply with regulation 19 (1) (a) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended, which state that:

"Where basic assessment must be applied to an application, the applicant must, within 90 days of receipt of the application by the competent authority, submit to the competent authority -

(a) a basic assessment report, inclusive of specialist reports, an EMPr, and where applicable a closure plan, which have been subjected to a public participation process of at least 30 days and which reflects the incorporation of comments received, including any comments of the competent authority"

Should there be significant changes or new information that has been added to the basic assessment report or EMPr which changes or information was not contained in the reports or plans consulted on during the initial public participation process, you are therefore required to comply with regulation 19 (b) which state:

"notification in writing that the basic assessment report, inclusive of specialist reports an EMPr, and where applicable, a closure plan, will be submitted within 140 days of receipt of the application by the competent authority, as significant changes have been made or significant new information has been added to the basic assessment report or EMPr or, where applicable, a closure plan, which changes or information was not contained in the reports or plans consulted on during the initial public participation process contemplated in sub-regulation (1) (a) and that the revised reports or, EMPr or, where applicable, a closure plan will be subjected to another public participation process of at least 30 days".

You are further reminded that the final report to be submitted to this Department must comply with all the requirements in terms of the scope of assessment and content of the basic assessment reports in accordance with Appendix 1 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended.

You are hereby reminded of Section 24F of the National Environmental Management Act, Act No 107 of 1998, as amended, that no activity may commence prior to an environmental authorisation being granted by the Department.

COMMENT ON THE DRAFT BASIC ASSESSMENT REPORT ("BAR") FOR THE PROPOSED ESKOM DAGBREEK BYPASS PROJECT ON PORTION 38 OF FARM RONDEHEUWEL NO. 25, HERMON

- The draft Basic Assessment Report dated August 2017, as received by the Department on 1 August 2017, refers.
- 2. It is the Department's understanding that:
 - 2.1 The project entails the connection of two power lines which is on either side of a railway line by means of an approximate 380m long 66kV power line.
 - A 140m wide route corridor is being investigated, which will allow for slight deviations 2.2 of the power line within the conidor.
 - 2.3 The power line runs across ploughed/fallow lands that would have comprised of Atlantis Sand Fynbos, an ecosystem classified as critically endangered in terms of Section 52 of the National Environmental Management Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act No. 10 of 2004) ("NEMBA").
 - 2.4 Only design alternatives for the pylons have been investigated and will be confirmed during the design phase.
 - 2.5 According to the Botanist, the impact and fauna and flora will be negligible.
 - 2.6 There is no surface water bodies within the immediate vicinity,
 - 2.7 Temporary access to the site (±300m) is required under the power line for the construction period.

- 3. The Department has the following comments:
 - 3.1 On 7 April 2017 the Minister of Environmental Affairs promulgated amendments to the regulations in terms of Chapter 5 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) ("NEMA"), viz., the EIA Regulations 2014 (Government Notice ("GN") No. R. 326, R. 327, R. 325 and R. 324 in Government Gazette No. 40772 of 7 April 2017). These regulations came into effect on 7 April 2017. Your attention is therefore drawn to the following:
 - 3.1.1 You are therefore requested to consult the new listed notices as contained in GN No. R. 327, R. 325 and R. 324 of 7 April 2017 and to include all activities (similarly and/or newly listed) applicable to the application in the in-process BAR. You will also be required to indicate how the impacts of the additional activities, listed in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), have been adequately assessed. In addition to this, all (registered) Interested and Affected Parties must be informed of any new listed activities that may be triggered in terms of the EIA Regulations 2014 (as amended), as well as the potential impacts thereof.
 - 3.2 Given that the bypass infrastructure would be \pm 380m in length, you are required to provide clarity regarding the applicability of the activity, since the activity excludes the development of bypass infrastructure that is 2 kilometres or shorter in length,
 - 3.3 You are furthermore reminded that the final BAR must contain all the information outlined in Appendix 1 and 4 of GN No. 326 of 7 April 2017 (as amended).
- 4. Kindly quote the above-mentioned reference number in any future correspondence in respect of the application.
- 5. Please note that the activity may not commence prior to an environmental authorisation being granted by the Department.
- The Department reserves the right to revise initial comments and request further information based on the information received.

CapeNature would like to thank you for the opportunity to comment on this proposed activity and wish to make the following comments:

The area in which the proposed bypass is located was historically covered by Atlantis Sand Fynbos with Swartland Shale Renosterveld occurring nearby. Most of the proposed powerline servitude has been previously ploughed however, it must be noted that several Species of Conservation Concern (SCC) have been identified in the road and railway reserves close to the bypass site.

CapeNature does not object to the proposed bypass provided that it is not located further to the south-west than indicated in Appendix A. Even though we agree that the likelihood of SCC occurring within the disturbance footprint of the bypass is low, no clearing of vegetation should take place without the supervision of the ECO who must ensure that only invasive alien vegetation is removed and that SCC are not accidentally or intentionally removed.

The Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) is quite generic and we recommend removing some of the generic mitigation measures that are not applicable to this site so that the site-specific mitigation measures are given greater emphasis.
