EXTENSION OF THE VALIDITY PERIOD OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 30 APRIL 2013 FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF A 132kV POWER LINE ASSOCIATED WITH THE 75MW CONCENTRATING PHOTOVOLTAIC (CPV)/PHOTOVOLTAIC (PV) PLANT ON THE FARM DROOGFONTEIN (PV 2) IN KIMBERLEY, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE

Your letter dated 22 February 2016 received by this Department on the 22 February 2016, requesting for an extension of validity period of the amended Environmental Authorisation (EA) of the abovementioned project issued by this Department on 30 April 2013 refers.

With reference to the abovementioned letter for the extension of the EA; please be advised that the Department has decided to grant an extension of the amended EA issued on 30 April 2013 for the construction of a 132kV power line associated with the 75MW Concentrating Photovoltaic (CPV)/Photovoltaic (PV) Plant on the Farm Droogfontein (PV2)

The extension is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The activity must commence within a period of three (3) years from the date of expiry of the amended EA issued on 30 April 2013 now extended to 30 April 2019. If commencement of the activity does not occur within that period, the authorisation lapses and a new application for environmental authorisation must be made in order for the activity to be undertaken.
- The correspondence is only for the extension of the validity period as stated herein above and all
 conditions set out in the original Environmental Authorisation dated 30 April 2013 remain unchanged
 and must be adhered to.

This letter must be read in conjunction with the original EA dated 30 April 2013.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (the Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the Department's decision in respect of the amendment made as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the National Appeals Regulations, 2014.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of Government Notice No. R.993, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed.

An appellant must submit an appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the competent authority.
