APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 02 FEBRUARY 2015 FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF THE MOOKODI-GANYESA 132 KV POWERLINE, NEW PROPOSED GANYESA SUBSTATION AND HAVELOCK LILO, NORTH WEST PROVINCE.

The environmental authorisation (EA) (Reference No: 14/12/16/3/3/1/680) issued by the Department on 02 February 2015, the EA amendment application received by the Department on 28 June 2017, the assessment and public participation report received by the Department on 03 October 2017 and the additional information received by the Department via e-mail on 19 October 2017, refer.

The recommendations made by the Surface Water Assessment and the revised hydrological report included in the amendment application form must be adhered to as they are included as part of the revised EMPr. Further all the recommendations contained in the EMPr must be implemented. The EMPr should be regarded as a 'living document', which must be amended from time to time as and when the need arises. Your attention is drawn to Regulations 35, 36, and 37 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (as amended), for the future amendments of the EMPr.

This letter must be read in conjunction with the Environmental Authorisation dated 02 February 2015.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's decision in respect of your application as well as the fact that an appeal may be lodged against the decision in terms of the National Appeals Regulations, and the provisions regarding the submission of appeals as contained in the Regulations.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
