Die Braamhoek Pompoggarskema (BPOS) is 23 km noordwaarts van Van Reenen geleë op die plateau van die Drakensberge. Die gebied bestaan uit twee reservoires, insluitende torenlaatstele en pompoggarskema, waaroor omgewingsvergelyking reeds verkry is in terme van die Wet op Omgewingsvergelyking (Wet 73 van 1989). As deel van die BPOS, word hiermee kennis gage in naam van Reguliere 4(6) van die regulasies gepubliseer in die Staatskoerant Nr. R1183 onder Artikel 20 van die Wet op Omgewingsbewaring, Wet 73 van 1989, van Eskom as voorname om die volgende aktiwiteite uit te voer:

• 400KV Transmisiekraglyn & Substasie-Integrasie (OIBs 12/12/06/572 & 12/12/20/673 & 12/12/20/674) vir die BPOS.

Die integrasieprojek bestaan uit drie afsonderlike konposities:

- Die Braamhoek Substasie: om elektrisiteit vanaf die Braamhoek Kraglyn te ontvange.
- Die Braamhoek-Venus 400KV transmisiekraglyn, om 'n tweede konneksie met die Nasionale Transmisie Netwerkstelsel te voorstaan via 'n direkte konneksie met die Venus Substasie.
- 'n Aansluiting vanaf die bestaande Majuba-Venus 400 KV transmisiekraglyn om die Substasie met die Nasionale Transmisie Netwerkstelsel te verbind.

Dit OIBs sal alternatiewe sels vir die plasing van die substasie en transmisiekraglyne ondersoek.

## Suspension of employees

In serious cases of misconduct, it is common practice to suspend the employee on full pay pending the outcome of the disciplinary action. Failure to pay the employee who remains willing and able to work would constitute a breach of contract. The question is under what circumstances suspension without pay may be used as a penalty or corrective measure.

Where misconduct seriously damages the employment relationship, for example in a case of gross insubordination, there might be sufficient reason to dismiss the employee. However, as corrective action is preferable to dismissal, suspension without pay is an option to consider. In the case of NUMSA obo Thsikana vs. Delta Motor corporation that came before the CCMA last year, the commissioner, referring to certain labour Court decisions on the matter, found that the suspension had been fair. He noted that insubordination would in many instances be regarded as serious enough to justify dismissal and that the company had been lenient in the case before him.

As far as procedure is concerned, the commissioner stated that it couldn't be expected from an employer to hold a formal disciplinary hearing every time an employee breaches a rule. If dismissal were a possible sanction, disciplinary hearing would be required. In this case, however, dismissal was not considered. In view of the facts and circumstances,

#### ESKOM BRAAMHOEK 400kV TRANSMISSION POWER LINE & SUBSTATION INTEGRATION EIAs

#### CONSTRUCTION & UPGRADE OF ACCESS ROADS EA FOR THE ESKOM BRAAMHOEK PUMPED STORAGE SCHEME

The Braamhoek Pumped Storage Scheme (BPSS) is situated 23 km northeast of Van Reenen on the farm Braamhoek, Zastron and Bedford, on the boundary of KwaZulu-Natal and the Free State. The scheme will comprise two reservoirs, enclosed tunnel systems and pump turbine units for which environmental authorisation have already been obtained in terms of the Environment Conservation Act, Act 73 of 1998.

As part of the BPSS, notice is hereby given in terms of Regulation 4(6) of the regulations published in Government Notice No. R1163 under Section 26 of the Environment Conservation Act, Act 73 of 1998, of Eskom's intent to carry out the following activities:

#### 400kV Transmission Power Line & Substation Integration (EIAs: 12/12/20/672, 12/12/20/673 & 12/12/20/674) for the BPSS

The integration project comprises the construction of transmission lines and substations.

- The Braamhoek Substation: to receive electricity from the Braamhoek Power Station.
- The Braamhoek-Venus 400kV transmission power line, to provide a second connection to the Transmission National Grid System via a direct connection to the Venus Substation.
- A "Turn-in" from the existing Majuba-Venus 400kV transmission power line to the Venus Substation from the Transvaal-Venus 400kV transmission power line.

#### Construction & Upgrade of Access Roads (EA: A2/16/3/11) to the BPSS

This project involves the construction and upgrade of access roads to the Braamhoek Pumped Storage Scheme. Eskom is currently investigating various alternatives for access road routes that have been identified, in order to ascertain the preferred alternative. It is expected that most of the access roads will follow existing roads, which will have to be upgraded. Of the 11 km of access roads, approximately 90 km are new roads, only about 20 km may be old roads.
