Synopsis

This report is a summary of the public participation process conducted in support of the integrated application for the Proposed Upgrade of Two Existing Ash Dams and the Construction of Two Rehabilitation Dams at the Majuba Power Station's Ash Disposal Facility (ADF). The public participation process was conducted in accordance with the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), 107 of 1998 as amended, and the 2017 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations.

Advisian, a WorleyParsons (Pty) Ltd Group Company, was appointed by ESKOM Holdings SOC Limited, as an independent environmental consultant to facilitate the Scoping and Environmental Impact Reporting (S&EIR) process for Proposed Upgrade of Two Existing Ash Dams and the Construction of Two Rehabilitation Dams at the Majuba Power Station's Ash Disposal Facility (ADF).

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1 Introduction

1.1 Project Description

The Majuba Power Station is a six (6) unit coal fired power plant situated within Mpumalanga with a capacity to generate 4 110MW of energy.

An Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process was previously undertaken for the continuous ADF and an Integrated Environmental Authorisation (DEA reference number 14/12/16/3/3/3/53) received from the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA).

A change in the scope of work during the detailed engineering design for the ADF, necessitates the construction of two new Rehabilitation Dams (RD) and the upgrading of the two existing ash dams (AD). The Rehabilitation and Ash Dams are utilised for stormwater management within the larger ADF area.

The required dams will comprise a total combined surface area of more than 20ha which necessitates that a Scoping & EIR Process under the National Environmental Management Act, Act 107 of 1998, as amended (NEMA) be followed. This process includes a Public Participation Process.

The proposed development will require an Integrated Environmental Authorisation to be issued by the National Department of Environmental Affairs, as the project will trigger certain listed activities in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) (Act 107 of 1998, as amended) and the National Environmental Management: Waste Act (NEMWA) (Act 59 of 2008).

The proposed development will also require a Water Use Licence to be issued by the Department of Water and Sanitation in terms of the National Water Act (NWA) (Act 36 of 1998).

Advisian, a WorleyParsons (Pty) Ltd Group Company, have been appointed Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd, as an independent environmental consultant to facilitate the required Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment (S&EIA) Process required to obtain the necessary authorisations, including the associated Public Participation Process (PPP) for the proposed development.

1.2 The Public Participation Process

As per the principles enshrined in the Constitution including the NEMA, IAP engagement is a right and understood to be a series of inclusive and culturally appropriate interactions aimed at providing stakeholders with opportunities to express their views so that these can be considered and incorporated into the S&EIR decision-making process. Effective public participation requires the prior disclosure of relevant and adequate project information to enable stakeholders to understand the risks, impacts, and opportunities of the proposed project.

This PPP will be undertaken in accordance with the principles of integrated environmental management as highlighted in the NEMA (Chapter 1), including Chapter 6 of the 2014 EIA Regulations (as amended in 2017), regulation 39 to 44; as well as in accordance with Section 17, Procedure for public participation, of the National Water Act.

The PPP for this project will commence in two phases:

Phase 1:

A formal participation phase for the review and comment of the Application and Draft Scoping Report (DSR) including the Plan of Study for the Environmental Impact Assessment.



Phase 2:

A formal participation phase for the review and comment of the Draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report (DEIR).

1.3 Public Participation Process Objectives

The objectives of the Public Participation Process (PPP) can be summarised as follows:

- Identify relevant individuals of the general public, communities, civic organisations and state departments or agencies who may be interested in or affected by the proposed development;
- Clearly outline the scope of the proposed development, including the scale and nature of the existing and proposed activities;
- Identify viable project alternatives that will assist the relevant authorities in making an informed decision;
- To identify and address any environmental or social concerns through Interested and Affected Parties (IAPs) familiar with the project area and surroundings;
- To provide stakeholders the opportunity to voice any concern related to the project;
- To provide stakeholders the opportunity to review and provide feedback on the Application Form, the Technical Assessment (Scoping / EIA) Report, including the relevant specialist studies to ensure that the identified issues are adequately and suitably addressed.
- Inform stakeholders of the proposed solutions or mitigations measures which will be implemented to mitigate the potential impacts identified.

2 PPP Phase 1: Project Application and Scoping

Advisian undertook the following activities as part of the Project Application and Scoping Phase:

- Identify and registration of all IAPs.
- Notify the relevant Competent and Commenting Authorities about the proposed development.
- Notify all identified IAPs of about the proposed development.
- Circulation of the DSR to IAPs and Authorities for a 30-day review and comment period from 30 January 2019 up to and including 01 March 2019.
- A midday and evening Public Meeting on 21 March 2019 in the Town Hall of Volksrust; and
- The compilation of this PPP Report for the Scoping phase.

2.1 Identification of Stakeholders

The project database of Interested and Affected Parties (IAPs) was compiled, including all relevant authorities, stakeholders and public parties during the initial phase of the proposed project. The previous Environmental Impact Assessment database was made use of and expanded to include all currently relevant stakeholders.

2.2 Newspaper Advertisements

Two Public Meeting Sessions were arranged to be held at the Town Hall of Volksrust in Mpumalanga on 21 February 2019. The first session was arranged from 13:00 to 15:00 in the afternoon. The second session was arranged from 18:00 to 20:00 in the evening. The two different sessions were arranged in order to accommodate the timetables of all invitees.

Notification E-Mails were sent to all identified Authorities and IAPs on 13 February 2019 inviting them to the Public Meeting Sessions.

Despite the arrangements and notifications to all identified authorities and IAPs the turnout for the meetings were very poor.

2.7 E-Mail Notifications for the Extension of the Draft Scoping Report Review and Comment Period

Due to an administrative mishap the competent authority informed that the official start date of this Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment had been amended to 18 February 2019. Because of this the 30-day review and commenting period had to be moved out as well.

Notification E-Mails were sent out to all identified Authorities and Interested and/or affected Parties informing them of the extension of the review period up to and including 20 March 2019. With this extension notification a request was made to submit any comments, information, questions, or concerns regarding the proposed project and the Draft Scoping Report.

throughout. We are also monitored internally by a Section 79 unit, although we also ensure we're on the right track.

"We coordinate that both administratively and politically. Sometimes each component would visit projects unannounced. We report back to our leadership structures. Another thing that is our secret is the issue of unity and working together. The most important factor here is that the political leadership, which we call the Troika, which is myself as the executive mayor, the chief whip and Speaker of council. We are a close and united unit.

"If you look at most local municipalities, the problem lies in the lack of unity in the Troika. Within the top three there are camps and cracks. If the Troika has cracks and divisions, then the administration will also relax and all hell will break loose and it directly affects service delivery.

"In most cases, plans are there, but there's no implementation. So in essence, our biggest secret is the working together of the mayor, speaker and the chief whip. You can announce it to the rest of the world. We don't get offended when the speaker, for instance, would do a duty that belongs to me, instead I would support him. This is also vice versa, as long as the commitment is completed.

"That is the secret - to work together in unison and respect one another. Our administration works independently, there

is no interference in any way. We've said to them: no to fraud and no to corruption. We have examples because people who have committed fraud, we fired instantly. We fired many staff members because humans are prone to corruptible ways and short cuts.

"To be able to implement the above, we also have to be corruption-free. That, in a nutshell, is our secret to running local government, but it is deeply entrenched in this unity," said Chirwa.

Nkosi, on the other hand, articulated the successful pothole-patching initiative through which the municipality has managed to utilise cooperatives to do the work in their respective local municipalities.

But the biggest success is that they bought pothole-patching machinery that rehabilitates potholes for a very long period.

"We also bought seven other pieces of machinery for all the

local municipalities to utilise too," he said. Regarding the matriculants, Chirwa said, "We are aware that in the country there is free higher education. We've looked at our own situation here in the district that there are those scarce skills like engineering and finance for our municipalities. We're looking at awarding bursaries to students from disadvantaged backgrounds who are interested in those skills that we direly need here.

"We're looking at awarding bursaries to students that will return to impart their skills within this municipality and the province at large," he said.



Tensions flaring during Morgenzon protest

Tensions ran sky high in Morgenzon with entrances being blocked off on 23 and 24 January, primarily because of service delivery issues.

The protest allegedly erupted in Morgenzon on 23 January after Mr Linda Dhlamini, Lekwa Executive Mayor, was a no-show to receive a memorandum drawn up by the community, under leadership of march coordinator, Mr V A Gwebu.

Protesters barricaded the entrances to the town with burning tyres and rocks.

According to a farmer in the area, vehicles could not approach Morgenzon without risking stones being hurled at their vehicles.

When confronting one of the farmers about Mr Gwebu's statement, he responded that the farmers agree with every single point in the memorandum and even other issues not listed, but they were not going to allow protesters to run rampant and cause havoc by destroying property and intimidating people.

"Protesters are breaking down signs, causing damage to municipal and private property and not only threatening peoples' lives, but also their livelihood.

"We are all in agreement, but do not condone however, the way the protest is being conducted."

Mr Gwebu met up with the Standerton Advertiser outside the Standerton Magistrate's Court and said they were willing to engage with the farmers to discuss a way forward.

The Standerton Advertiser also contacted a farmer who was willing to see whether they could come to an amicable solution by contacting Mr Gwebu.

Mr Gwebu was asked whether this whole scenario with the farmers is not derailing their attempts to address the actual problem, namely service delivery.

He said: "I think so, because now we are going to lose focus."

Mr Gwebu also said that they have been trying to get a hold of Mr Dhlamini telephonically and were even escorted by police to his office, but he is apparently missing in action.

The Standerton Advertiser tried in vain to contact Ms Thobeka Mtshiselwa, Lekwa's communications manager, to find out where the mayor is and why he is not addressing the community of Morgenzon to restore the calm.

Learners at Morgenzon Landbou Akademie were also sent home, but some remained in the school's hostels

He said there was a contingent that offered safety to residents at the high school, Morgenzon Landbou Akademie, but that other parts of town were unsafe.

Kasselman Security Services (KSS) had personnel stationed in town along with other stakeholders, police and farmers in the community, who monitored the situation carefully.

Police allegedly also fired rubber bullets at protesters during the unrest.

The protest subsided at about 9pm on 23 January and protesters dispersed.

The road from Standerton to Morgenzon however, was again barricaded with a tree

and other entrances were also closed-off the following day, 24 January.

According to another resident who wished to stay anonymous, police's presence were heightened.

Business came to a complete halt, as most businesses were forced to close their doors.

The resident alleged that he had to send his employees home, as they were intimidated and told that their houses would be burned if they continue working.

Learners at Morgenzon Landbou Akademie were also sent home, but some however, remained in the school's hostels.

The Standerton Advertiser was told that many farmers were safeguarding the school

to protect the remaining learners.

The resident also speculated that protesters wanted to enter the water treatment plant, but that police and farmers would not allow it.

When Mr Gwebu was asked why they wished to enter the treatment plant, he said they wanted to prohibit employees from working and wanted to close down the plant, seeing that it is non-functional anyway.

The Advertiser also asked Mr Gwebu why the protest turned violent and why a stand-off was reached between some of the protesters and farmers.

He said that armed farmers were provoking protesters by moving in the same

Ash Disposal Facility Management

The Majuba Power Station ADF is being operated and managed according to their authorisations and management plans.

In order to do dust suppression, pollution control and rehabilitation of the ADF, pollution control dams (PCD) are used on site. Water runoff is collected via concrete perimeter drains and diverted to one of the PCDs. The PCD are divided into the following:

- Ash Dams (AD) - Contaminated runoff from active ash disposal areas.
- Rehabilitation Dams (RD) - Clean water runoff from rehabilitated areas.

- No archaeological sites of significance are on record for the study areas.
- No historical structures (older than 60 years) or cultural finds occur in the study areas.
- No burials or cemeteries were found in the study area.
- No graves were recorded in the study area during the field visit.

Groundwater Specialist Study

Groundwater Levels and Flow

On average the water levels within Majuba Power Station area at a depth of 3.06 mbg; a minimum of 0.31 mbgl between ADF and Witbankspruit; and maximum of 11.75mbgl between the ADF and Palmietspruit.

Ground Water Quality

Two types of groundwater have been observed:

- Calcium-bicarbonate (Ca-HCO₃) water which originates as runoff (Ash moisture, dust suppression, etc.). This is typical of shallow, freshly recharged water; and
- Sodium-bicarbonate (Na-HCO₃) water which occurs in the deeper aquifer within the fracture rock aquifer found in sandstone and dolerite.

Groundwater Monitoring

- Has been occurring on the site since 1990. Currently, no significant change in the physical or chemical quality has been observed for the site.


Surface Water Specialist Study

All watercourses draining the site and surrounding areas flow into the Geelklipspruit, which flows north-west into the Vaal River.

Surface water bodies potentially affected by the proposed project:

- A non-perennial river originating from the vicinity of AD3, draining westwards (1 on map);
- A non-perennial tributary located north of AD2, which drains in a northerly direction (2 on map); and
- A series of wetland seeps located just east of the AD1 (3 on map).

Ecology Specialist Study

The vegetation and habitats at the sites for the proposed dams are transformed or disturbed - limited natural vegetation remaining.

Almost no negative ecological impacts within these expansion areas are anticipated.

However the natural drainage areas and grassland surrounding the proposed dams are considered to be sensitive habitats of importance that would have to be protected from the content of the dams. (Refer to map indicating habitat sensitivity.)

Mitigation measures are contained within standard operation procedures and best practice guidelines for construction. This will also be addressed and described in the EIA report.




