After carefully reviewing your letter this Department is of the opinion that the placement of Solar Photo-Voltaics Facility on an old rehabilitated ash disposal facility at Grootvlei Power Station will not trigger any waste management activities that require a waste management license. The opinion is informed by the information provided in your "Technical scope of work for the portion of the proposed PV facility that will be placed on the platform of the ADF" which is attached as Appendix A to your letter. However should the scope of the work that will be undertaken during the placement and operation of the Solar Photo-Voltaics Facility change and trigger waste management activities listed under in GN 718, dated 3rd July 2009 you will be required to apply for a waste management license.
