PUBLIC PARTICIPATION NOTICE – BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED CAR PARK EXTENSION PROJECT AT KOEBERG NUCLEAR POWER STATION ON CAPE FARM DUYNFONTYN NO. 1552, WESTERN CAPE.

ESKOM is proposing an extension to an existing car park situated within the Koeberg Nuclear Power Station (KNPS) site on Cape Farm Duynfontyn No. 1552 (*refer to Annexure 1 for a Project Locality map*). The Car Park Extension Project will provide an additional 200 permanent (paved) and 200 temporary (gravel) parking bays with an expected development footprint of approximately 11 000m².

KNPS performs a refuelling outage approximately every 18 months on each Reactor Unit (i.e. between one and two outages per year). The current car park facility is inadequate to support the parking required for the additional outage workforce and thus the motivation for the Car Park Extension Project.

In terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), Act 107 of 1998 (as amended) and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (2014) the proposed project requires Environmental Authorisation from the Competent Authority, namely the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA), due to potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project activities. The project is therefore subjected to a BA Process in terms of applicable Listed Activities in Listing Notices 1 and 3, which includes a Public Participation Process (PPP). Advisian have been appointed by ESKOM as an independent environmental consultant to conduct the required Basic Assessment (BA) Process for the proposed project.

Notice is hereby given to all Interested and Affected Parties (IAP's) of the commencement of the proposed project's PPP. The Draft Scoping Report will be available for review and comment from **27 October to 28 November 2016** at the following locations:
