



1 PROJECT BACKGROUND

Kriel Power Station is a coal fired power station comprising of six units which produce a combined base load of 3 000 MW. The power station has a remaining operating life of 26 years and is scheduled to be decommissioned in 2039. To generate 3 000 MW of electricity coal is burnt by the boilers which produces ash as a waste product. The ash is then disposed of and stored on the Ash Dam.

Kriel Power Station Ash Dam will reach its maximum capacity in approximately June 2017 and Eskom is currently in the process of designing and undertaking the environmental authorisation for a new Ash Dam. However, according to the latest schedule a new ash dam will only be commissioned in September 2020, thus Kriel will not have sufficient capacity to deal with the ash generated between 2017 and 2020.

Eskom has therefore proposed the Kriel-Matla Ash Transfer Link which will involve the following, as an intermediate solution for a period of approximately 3.5 - 4 years until the new Kriel Ash Dam is developed:

- The transferring of 100% of Kriel Power Station Ash to Matla Power Station Ash Dam.
- The return of all Kriel Ash Water from the Matla Power Station Ash Dam to Kriel Power Station.

Notice is hereby given, in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) and the 2014 EIA Regulations (Government Notice (GN) No. R983 and R985 of 04 December 2014) of the intent to carry out a Basic Assessment (BA) Process for the proposed Kriel-Matla Ash Transfer Link.

2 PURPOSE OF THE BACKGROUND INFORMATION DOCUMENT

The key objective of the Background Information Document (BID) revolves around conveying relevant and key information regarding the proposed project to all those parties who are likely to be affected by the proposed bulk water development, thereby also fostering public involvement. The BID provides an overview of the following:

- The various aspects of the environmental processes that is required for the implementation of the proposed project;
- An understanding of the proposed project; and
- A locality map indicating the position of the development.

Furthermore the BID also provides stakeholders with the opportunity to register as Interested and Affected Parties (IAPs) and to raise their issues and concerns with regards to the proposed Kriel-Matla Transfer link. Please see the

end of this document for details as to how to register as an IAP.

3 PROJECT DESCRIPTION




Figure 1: Topographical Map (1: 50 000) of the Kriel-Matla Transfer Link.

The proposed project will involve the development of four new ash pipelines from Kriel to Matla as well as an Ash Water Return (AWR) System comprising of three AWR pipelines. In addition, a new Booster Pump House for Kriels AWR will be constructed adjacent to the existing Matla Booster Pump House, which will accommodate three new booster pumps. New solution trenches will also be put in place. The proposed pipelines are indicated in **Figure 1**.

4 PROJECT LOCATION

The proposed pipelines will be located between the Kriel Power Station and Matla Power Station, both of which are situated within the Emalahleni Local Municipality and Nkanagla District Municipality in the Mpumalanga Province of South Africa between the towns of Bethal and Ogies on the R545 road.

5 REGULATORY FRAMEWORK

The proposed development falls within the ambit of the NEMA, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) and National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) (NWA).

5.1 Basic Assessment (BA):

In terms of GN No. R983 and R985 of 04 December 2014 of the NEMA (Act No. 107 of 1998), a specific list of activities were identified which could have a detrimental impact on the receiving environment. These listed activities require Environmental Authorisation from the Competent Authority, i.e. the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA). Details of the triggered listed activities are provided in **Table 1**.

Accordingly, the proposed project requires authorisation from DEA via the BA process outlined in GN No. 982 of 04 December 2014 of NEMA, 1998.

The Basic Assessment Report (BAR) contains the details of the assessment conducted, specialist investigations, project design and impacts that have been identified and proposed mitigation measures to counter potential impacts. A Draft copy of the BAR is available for public review from 11 November 2015 to 11 December 2015, prior to finalisation and submission of the BAR to DEA. Only **registered** IAPs will continue to be notified of the BA process. Please see the end of this document for details as to how to register as an IAP.

5.2 Water Use License Application (WULA):

Please note that in terms of the NWA, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998), a Water Use Licence Application (WULA), is required for the following uses:

- Section 21 (c) – Impeding of diverting the flow of water in a water course; and
- Section 21 (i) – Altering the bed, banks, course or characteristics of a watercourse.

A WULA has been compiled by Digby Wells Environmental and a draft copy of the WULA is included an Annexure to the Draft BAR and will also be available for

review between 11 November 2015 to 11 December 2015.

6 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Public Participation will be conducted in terms of Chapter 6 of GN No. 982 of 04 December 2014, NEMA, (Act No. 107 of 1998) and the Public Participation Guideline (Government Gazette No. 35769 on 10 October 2012). The Public Participation Process will involve the following:

1. Site notices will be erected at prominent points on and around the study area;
2. BIDs will be distributed by email to general IAPs. Where email addresses are not available, notification messages will be sent;

3. BIDs will be left at prominent points in Kriel such as the Kriel Public Library and the security office at Kriel and Matla Power Stations;
4. BIDs regarding the project will be e-mailed or faxed to the councillors in the area;
5. Copies of the Draft BAR will be submitted to commenting authorities;
6. An advertisement will be placed in Witbank News.

IAPs are encouraged to participate in the process in order for concerns to be addressed and included in the BAR and WULA. IAPs are to review and comment on the draft documents which will be lodged at the following place for review from **11 November 2015 to 11 December 2015**:


Locality Map

PROJECT PROCESSES

- New solution trenches will also be put in place.








Matla-Kriel Ash Transfer Link

6. CONCLUSION

The following pertinent conditions for inclusion in the Environmental Authorisation are recommended:

- Appointment of an Environmental Control Officer to monitor compliance with the Environmental Authorisation and the approved Environmental Management Programme;
- All mitigation measures provided in Appendix D, Appendix F, Appendix I and Appendix G (Specialist reports, WULA, Impact Assessment and EMPr) of the BAR are to be adhered to. Specifically the following:
 - Site clearing of flora, taking into account the rehabilitation potential.
 - Search and rescue of plant species of conservation importance.
 - Encroachment of alien vegetation should be monitored regularly and controlled.
 - Should any remains be found on site that is potentially human remains, the South African Police Service should also be contacted.
 - Rehabilitate and revegetate the excavated areas.
 - Erosion prevention and sediment control measures need to be implemented

If the above recommendations and the EMPr are strictly enforced to mitigate the identified possible impacts associated to it, then construction disruptions should have minimal lasting effect on the ecosystems of the proposed development

Kriel Power Station Ash Dam will reach its maximum capacity in approximately June 2017 and Eskom is currently in the process of designing and undertaking the environmental authorisation for a new Ash Dam. However, according to the latest schedule a new ash dam will only be commissioned in September 2020, thus Kriel will not have sufficient capacity to deal with the ash generated between 2017 and 2020. Eskom has therefore proposed the Kriel-Matla Ash Transfer Link which will involve the following, as an intermediate solution for a period of approximately 3.5 - 4 years until the new Kriel Ash Dam is developed:
