Sebata Institute applied for the integrated Environmental Authorisation and Waste Management Licence on behalf of Eskom. The application was submitted to the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) on 17 August 2012 and an amended application was submitted on 28 February 2013 (DEA Ref: 14/12/16/3/3/3/51 and NEAS Ref: DEA/EIA/0001413/2012). In response to this application, the DEA requested that an EIA be conducted, taking into account all the applicable Departmental Guidelines throughout the application process.

The EIA will be conducted in terms of the 2010 EIA Regulations and will consist of the following phases;

- Authority Consultation and Environmental Impact Assessment Application;
- Scoping Phase;
- EIA Phase;
- Authorisation; and
- Appeals.
