**PROPOSED COAL-FIRED POWER STATION AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE
WITBANK GEOGRAPHICAL AREA:**

Invitation to Participate and Background Information Document

Your property has been identified as on or near one of two possible locations for a proposed new coal-fired power station in the Witbank geographical area. This proposed activity requires authorisation from the national environmental authority, viz. the national Department of Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEAT) via the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process outlined in Regulation 1183, under Section 26 of the Environment Conservation Act (73 of 1989). Eskom has appointed Ninhamb Shand Consulting Services as independent Environmental Assessment Practitioners, to assist them in complying with these legal requirements.

We have experienced extreme difficulty in identifying the landowners concerned and although we have communicated with most, we have appointed a conveyancer to assist us with confirming the few outstanding landowners. We have only recently received your contact details and apologise for the delay in communicating with you. As a potentially directly affected landowner we wish to provide you with background information and to invite you to register on our database and to raise any issues or concerns regarding this proposed project.

Project Background

Eskom's Integrated Strategic Electricity Planning (ISEP) process, which has been informed and guided by national policies and plans such as the White Paper on Energy, Integrated Energy Policy and the National Integrated Resource Plan (NIRP), has identified long-term options regarding both the supply and demand sides of electricity provision in South Africa. The latest NIRP and ISEP plan (October 2005) have identified the need for increased electricity supply in South Africa.

As part of the increased electricity supply plan, Eskom is considering a coal-fired power station and associated infrastructure in the vicinity of Witbank on the boundary between Mpumalanga and Gauteng provinces.

Background Information Document

Please find attached the Background Information Document (BID) which describes the proposed project and the associated EIA process. The BID is also available in Pedi and Zulu on request. We ask that you complete the attached Response Form and return it to us by 26 September 2006.¹

Uitnodiging tot Deelname en Agtergrond Inligtingsdokument**

U eiendom is geïdentifiseer om binne of naby aan die twee moontlike terreine vir 'n voorgestelde kragsentrale in die omgewing van Witbank geleë te wees. Volgens die proses vir 'n Omgewingsinvloedbepaling (OIB), soos omskryf in Regulasie 1183 onder artikel 26 van die Wet op Omgewingsbewaring (Wet Nr 73 van 1989), benodig sodanige aktiwiteit 'n magtiging vanaf die nasionale omgewingsowerheid, die Departement van Omgewingsake en Toerisme (DEAT). Ninham Shand Konsultantdienste is deur Eskom as die onafhanklike Omgewingspraktisyne aangestel om te verseker dat alle wetlike verpligte nagekom word.

Ons het heelwat probleme gehad om die alle betrokke grondeienaars op te spoor. Alhoewel ons reeds met meeste in verbinding getree het, moes ons 'n akteprokureur aanstel om inligting oor die oorblywende grondeienaars te bekom. Ons het u besonderhede dus eers onlangs ontvang en vra dus om verskoning vir die feit dat ons nou eers met u in verbinding tree. Aangesien u direk deur die projek geraak word, wil ons u graag van 'n agtergrond inligtingsdokument voorsien en uitnooi om as 'n belanghebbende en geaffekteerde party te regstreer, asook om enige kwessies of probleme wat u met die projek mag hê, aan ons deur te gee.

Agtergrond tot die Projek

Eskom se Geïntegreerde Elektrisiteitsbeplanningsproses (oftewel ISEP na aanleiding van die Engelse benaming: *Integrated Strategic Electricity Planning*) is gebaseer op die riglyne van verskeie dokumente soos die Witskrif op Energie, die Geïntegreerde Energiebeleid en Nasionale Geïntegreerde Hulpbronplan (oftewel NIRP na aanleiding van die Engelse benaming: *National Integrated Resource Plan*). Hierdie proses ondersoek die lang termyn-opsies vir beide die voorsiening van en aanvraag na elektrisiteit in Suid-Afrika. Die mees onlangse ISEP plan (Oktober 2005) identifiseer die behoefte aan 'n verhoogde aanvraag na elektrisiteit teen die jaar 2010.

As deel van die plan om elektrisiteitsvoorsiening te verhoog, beplan Eskom om 'n steenkool-aangedrewen kragsentrale in die omgewing van Witbank, op die grens tussen Mpumalanga en Gauteng, op te rig.
