ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED CONVENTIONAL NUCLEAR POWER STATION ('NUCLEAR 1'): AMENDMENT TO THE APPLICATION FORM (Your reference: 12/12/20/944)

The application dated 15 May 2007 for the proposed Pressurized Water Reactor (PWR) nuclear power station(s) has reference.

During the Scoping Phase new information obtained from specialist studies and Interested and Affected Parties has warranted a number of amendments to the listed activities. The required changes to the application form are listed below:

- The activity listed as 1(k) "the treatment of effluent, wastewater or sewage with an annual throughput capacity of more than 2 000 cubic metres but less than 15 000 cubic metres" was incorrectly numbered and must be amended to 1(s) "the treatment of effluent, wastewater or sewage with an annual throughput capacity of more than 2 000 cubic metres but less than 15 000 cubic metres."
- The following activities, from Government Notice No. R. 386 of 2006, must be added to the application:
 - 1(k) the bulk transportation of sewage and water, including storm water, in pipelines with -
 - (i) an internal diameter of 0,36 metres or more; or
 - (ii) a peak throughput of 120 litres per second or more;
 - 1(q) the landing, parking and maintenance of aircraft including -
 - (i) helicopter landing pads, excluding helicopter landing facilities and stops used exclusively by emergency services;
 - (ii) unpaved aircraft landing strips shorter than 1,4km;
 - (iii) structures for equipment and aircraft storage;
 - (iv) structures for maintenance and repair;
 - (v) structures for fuelling and fuel storage; and
 - (vi) structures for air cargo handling

- 3 The prevention of the free movement of sand, including erosion and accretion, by means of planting vegetation, placing synthetic material on dunes and exposed sand surfaces within a distance of 100 metres inland of the high-water mark of the sea.
- Please note the name of the contact person from Eskom has changed from Mr Tyrone Singleton to Ms Deidre Herbst.
- The list of nearest towns has been revised. Please find the newest list attached as Appendix A.

We kindly request that the list of activities for which authorisation is being sought be updated accordingly.
