The new computer centre provides children with access to 30 new computers all featuring internet connectivity, said chairman of the GHC board Patrick September. He said Olwazini in Zulu means 'place of knowledge' and that the board was proud the centre was fulfilling its educational role.

"The usefulness of science is to help mankind adapt to the laws of nature. This projected had humble beginnings but has now grown into a powerful facility with over 70 exhibits that caters for around 10 000 visitors a year. One makes this centre particularly relevant and unique is that it includes cultural aspects of knowledge which provides learners with a completeness that is not found in other similar initiatives," said September.

The keynote speaker at the launch was KwaZulu-Natal First Lady Dr. May Masheko-Mkhize reminisced about her education career and the lack of technology and resources previous generations had to cope with.

"I went through university without ever having to touch a computer and so today I stand here proud to be opening a computer centre as it provides a bridge for those children who are not fortunale enough to have access to these important resources... We must use this facility to instill a love for science among our children. This initiative is but one ripple and if we motivate others to invest we will have more ripples and eventually then a wave promoting science. I would like to see children from rural areas also be given the opportunity of visiting this centre and perhaps herein lies a CSI opportunity for another

corporate partner to help provide transport logistics that will assist impoverished school send their children here" said Dr.Mhize
