AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 11 JUNE 2012 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSED MITCHELL'S PLAIN SUBSTATION, THE SWITCHING STATION AND A 400kV DOUBLE CIRCUIT TRANSMISSION POWERLINE FROM THE PROPOSED MITCHELL'S PLAIN SUBSTATION TO ANOTHER PROPOSED SWITCHING STATION, CAPE TOWN METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Environmental Authorisation (EA) issued for the above application by this Department on 11 June 2012 and your application for amendment of the EA received by this Department on 10 May 2017 refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, to extend the validity period of the EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended has decided to amend the EA dated 11 June 2012, as follows:

The activity must commence within a period of five (05) years from the date of expiry of EA issued on 11 June 2012 (i.e. the EA lapses on 11 June 2022). If commencement of the activity does not occur within that period, the authorisation lapses and a new application for environmental authorisation must be made in order for the activity to be undertaken.

This proposed amendment letter must be read in conjunction with the EA dated 11 June 2012.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (the Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within 14 (fourteen) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's decision in respect of your application as well as the fact that an appeal may be lodged against the decision in terms of the National Appeals Regulations, and the provisions regarding the submission of appeals as contained in the Regulations.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
