NID: PROPOSED ESKOM ROBBERG - BITOU POWERLINE AND SUBSTATION, NEAR PLETTENBERG BAY

The matter above has reference.

Your NID received on 10 November 2013 was tabled and the following was discussed:

- 1. Three possible routes for the 9 km 66kV powerline from the Robberg Substation to two possible new substations on the Bitou River were assessed in the original AIA report considered at the APM meeting of 6 March 2007
- 2. A fourth possible route and a third possible substation location was later added.
- 3. The fourth route tracks routes 1 & 3 out of the Robberg Substation and the path deviates along the line of ponds of the Plettenberg Bay water works towards the N2.
- 4. Route alternative 4 has also been assessed for archaeology and visual impacts but was apparently not submitted to HWC.
- 5. Archaeological material found in the area is of low significance.
