DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

- a) "Eskom" means Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd (Reg No 2002/015527/30), a company incorporated in terms of the Company Law of the Republic of South Africa, with its registered head office at Megawatt Park, Maxwell Drive, Sandton;

- c) "User" means any person who enters or uses the Eskom website, notwithstanding the fact that such a person only visits the home page of the Eskom website;
- d) References herein to the singular include the plural and vice versa; and
- e) Hyperlinks herein to legal documents should be deemed part of these terms and conditions in terms of section 11(3) of the <u>ECT Act.</u> The fact that some or all of the hyperlinks may, from time to time, be non-operational, shall not affect the validity and interpretation of these terms and conditions.

1. GENERAL

Eskom is South Africa's state-owned electricity utility that generates, transmits and distributes electricity.

Countries in which operations are located

The operations of Eskom are located in South Africa. Eskom Enterprises, a subsidiary of Eskom, has operations on the African continent, with its head office located in Johannesburg, South Africa, and offices in Uganda.

Ownership

The ownership of Eskom vests in the South African government.

Nature of markets and customers served

Electricity is sold to industrial, mining, commercial, agricultural, and residential customers and redistributors.

Breakdown of sales by country/region

The majority of the sales are in South Africa, with only a small percentage of sales in the southern African region.

Additional information on economic, environmental, and social aspects

Eskom is committed to aligning itself with international sustainability reporting initiatives. Further

environmental and social information is available on the Eskom website.

2. ALLOWED USE AND LICENSE

- 2.1 Eskom licenses the User to view, download and print the content of the Eskom website, provided that such content is used for private, personal, educational and/or non-commercial purposes only.
- 2.2 Content from the Eskom website may not be used or exploited by Users for any commercial and non-private purposes without the prior written consent of Eskom.
- 2.3 Users may only access, browse and use the Eskom website for legitimate personal or commercial purposes and may not use the Eskom website or any Eskom services and/or products for:
 - 2.3.1 Harmful purposes;

3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

3.1 All intellectual property on the Eskom website, including but not limited to content, trademarks (or any confusingly similar trademarks), logos, pictures, video, downloads, domain names, patents, design elements, software, source code, meta tags, databases, text, graphics, icons and hyperlinks are the property of or licensed to Eskom and as such, are protected from infringement by domestic and international legislation and treaties. - 5.11 Alternative dispute resolution: Subject to urgent and/or interim relief, all disputes regarding:

 - 5.11.4 these terms and conditions, shall be referred to arbitration in terms of the expedited rules of the Arbitration Foundation of South Africa and such arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in Johannesburg in English. The arbitration ruling shall be final and the unsuccessful party shall pay the costs of the successful party on a scale as between attorney and own client.
