DRAFT ORDER

After reading the papers and hearing counsel for the applicant, it is ordered that:

Eskom's non-compliance with the Rules of Court relating to service and time periods and the practice manual of this Honourable Court be condoned and that this application be heard as one of urgency in accordance with Rule 6(12) of the Uniform Rules of Court.



- The decision of the first respondent ("NERSA") taken on 30 September 2021 and described in the notice of motion in this matter dated 14 October 2021 is reviewed and set aside.
- Eskom's revenue application for the 2023/24 financial year, submitted to NERSA on 2 June 2021, is to be decided by NERSA in accordance with the 2016 Multi Year Price Determination Methodology ("the existing Methodology", on a timetable to be determined by NERSA subject to the following:
 - 3.1 NERSA shall publish the 2023/24 revenue application on or before 1

 August 2022.

 - 3.2 NERSA shall provide a period for the public to make written representations in response to the 2023/24 revenue application.
 - 3.3 After the deadline for written representations in response to the 2023/24 revenue application, NERSA shall convene public hearings on the 2023/24 revenue application.
 - 3.4 NERSA shall make a final decision on 2023/24 revenue application on or before 24 December 2022.
 - The revenue application for 2024/25 shall be determined in terms of the Methodology which will be in existence at the time. This could include a methodology based on the amended Electricity Regulation Act and Electricity Pricing Policy or a methodology determined by NERSA after having completed the revision of the existing Methodology having regard to any other regulatory requirements for the industry.

- If NERSA publishes a new Price Determination Methodology and reviews all other related regulatory requirements for the industry by 30 September 2022, Eskom shall submit a revised 2024/25 revenue application by no later than 1 June 2023 to NERSA for consideration and approval by 20 December 2023.
- 6 Each party is to pay its own costs.
