NOTIFICATION ON THE DECISION FOR THE SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC AMENDMENT OF THE **ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ISSUED ON 8 MARCH 2016 AT THE ESKOM ARNOT**

POWER STATION, MPUMALANGA

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries (DEFF) has decided to grant amendment of the validity period for the Solar Photovoltaic Environmental Authorisation (EA), on 10 February 2021, at the Arnot Power Station in the Mpumalanga Province. The decision notification was received by Eskom on 15 February 2021. The initial EA was issued on 8 March 2016 with a validity period of 5 years and is now extended by another 5 years, until 8 March

2026.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended, the applicant is required to inform all registered Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs), in writing, and within 14 days of the date of the decision, of the Department's decision as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the EIA Regulations.

A copy of the decision is attached to this letter as **Appendix 1**.

Should you wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) Act No 1998, National Appeal Regulations published under GN R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303, dated 8 December 2014, which prescribes the appeal procedure to be followed. A copy of the National Appeal Regulations is attached to this letter as Appendix 2.
