# DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY

Construction and operation of two 765kV Transmission Power Lines linking the Gamma Substation, located south of Victoria West, Northern Cape, and the Grassridge Substation, located in Port Elizabeth, Eastern Cape.

Size and type: 2 x 765kV Transmission Power Lines. Each 765kV transmission power line will require a servitude width of 80 m. Each steel tower is approximately 50m to 55m in height and a cross rope tower design (new 765kV tower configuration) will be used. Strain towers will be used in bends and in difficult terrain.

Estimated cost of the project: The 2 x 765 kV Transmission Power Lines and Grassridge infrastructure will cost approximately R3-billion to construct.

Timeframe: The applicant wishes to commence construction in 2008 once the landowner/servitude negotiations process has been completed.

Receiving environment and society: From the Gamma substation, the transmission power line will traverse relatively flat and sparse terrain, comprising limited number of landowners each owning relatively large tracts of land. This is until the Ondersneeuberg Mountains, where the transmission power line will need to be aligned through some reasonable formidable terrain. From these mountains, the transmission power line alignment is via Aberdeen and Jansenville that is, again, relatively sparse with few landowners each owning relatively large tracts of land. From Jansenville onwards via Kirkwood to the Grassridge Substation, the alignment of the transmission power line may become problematic. There are numerous landowners, each with smaller parcels of land, many of whom are involved in or intent on becoming involved in eco-tourism/nature-based economic activities (and/or other intensive agricultural activities that would be negatively impacted by an 80 m servitude). This situation is made more complex due to the relatively narrow geographic corridor available between the Kleinwinterhoekberge and the Suurberge.
