PLAN OF STUDY FOR SCOPING: CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF TWO 765KV TRANSMISSION POWER LINES LINKING THE GAMMA SUBSTATION, LOCATED SOUTH OF VICTORIA WEST, NORTHERN CAPE, AND THE GRASSRIDGE SUBSTATION, LOCATED IN PORT ELIZABETH, EASTERN CAPE.

The Plan of Study for Scoping received on 12 May 2006 refers.

This Plan of Study is acceptable to DEAE&T provided that the following points are noted:

- Regional Eastern Cape Newspapers relevant to the area are The Herald and Die Burger. Check that all other selected newspapers are correct. The Sunday Times should be added as a national newspaper;
- Display materials used during public meetings should include potential negative impacts associated with power lines;
- Impacts regarded as insignificant should not be excluded from further consideration as a number of insignificant impacts may collectively have a significant impact; and
- Three weeks allowed for public comment of the Draft Scoping Report may be too short for a project of this magnitude. It is recommended that the review period be four weeks.
