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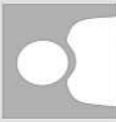

1 PURPOSE OF THE BACKGROUND INFORMATION DOCUMENT

The purpose of the Background Information Document (BID) is as follows:

1. It serves to provide an overview of the proposed Emkhiweni Substation and 400kV Line from Emkhiweni Substation to Silimela;
2. It provides an outline of the Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Process that will be undertaken for the project; and
3. It grants the opportunity to be registered as an Interested and Affected Party (IAP) and allows for comments to be made on the proposed project (refer to attached Reply Form).

The purpose of the EIA is to identify and evaluate potential impacts, to recommend measures to avoid or reduce negative impacts and to enhance positive impacts.

2 PROJECT OVERVIEW

2.1 Project Background

Nemai Consulting was appointed by Eskom in 2009 to undertake the EIA as part of the 2006 EIA Regulations for the following projects:

1. Construction of the Rockdale B Substation (now referred to as Emkhiweni Substation), with 2x500MVA 400/132kV transformers; and
2. Construction of the Rockdale B to Wolwekraal 400kV line (now referred to as the Emkhiweni Substation to Silimela 400kV line).

The projects were authorised in May 2011 (Emkhiweni Substation) and July 2011 (Emkhiweni-Silimela 400kV line). Eskom has decided to proceed with the construction of Emkhiweni-Silimela 400kV line (which is approximately 80kms) however the previous Record of Decision (RoD) has lapsed. Therefore Nemai Consulting are undertaking a new application for Environmental Authorisation (EA) as part of the 2014 EIA Regulations, as amended (07 April 2017). Eskom was not able to proceed with construction within the ROD timeframes as a result of the lack of funding for the project.

The proposed project is associated with the transmission network and its associated substations in the Mpumalanga and Limpopo Provinces.

2.2 Project Location

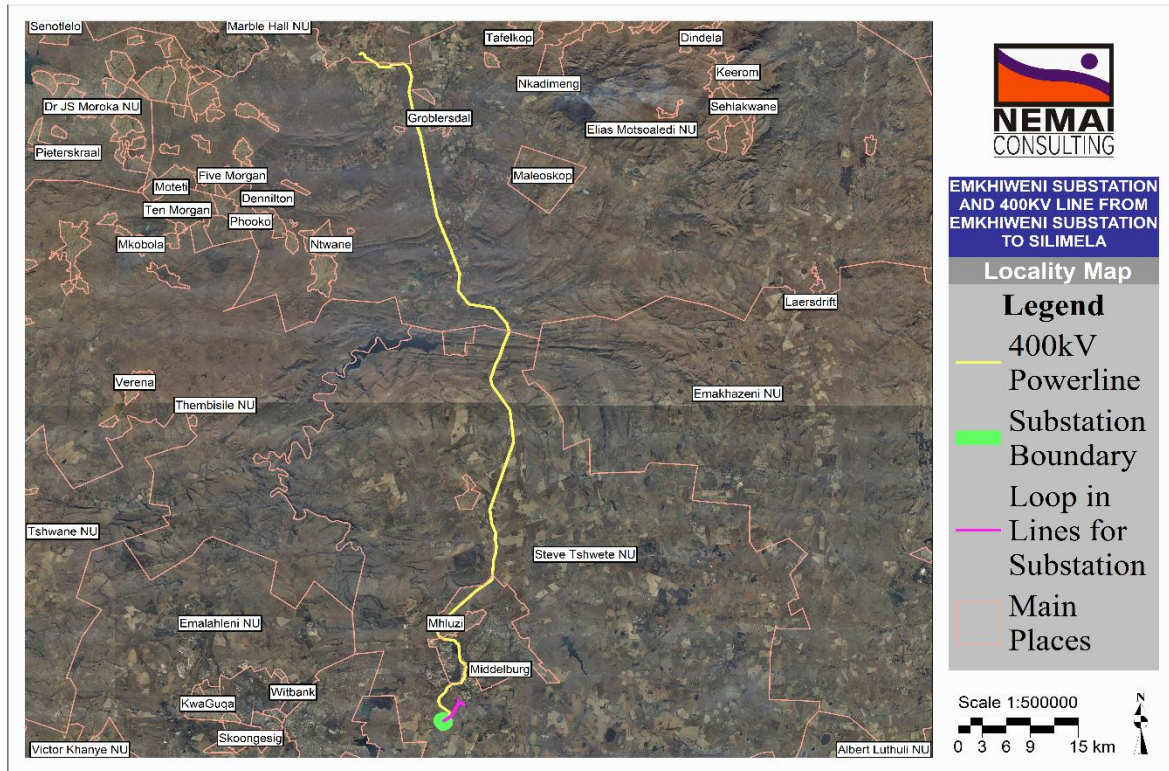


Figure 1: Locality map

The proposed activity entails the construction of a 400kV power line from the Middelburg area in the south to the Marble Hall/Wolwekraal area in the north. The proposed line originates at the Wolwekraal Substation, which is situated approximately 13km to the southeast of Marble Hall (Limpopo Province)

on the Farm Loskop Noord No. 12 JS and runs south-eastwards. The line terminates at the proposed Emkhiweni Substation within Mpumalanga. Refer to **Figures 1** and **2** for locality maps. The proposed development falls within the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality (LM), Elias Motsoaledi LM and Ephraim Mogale LM.

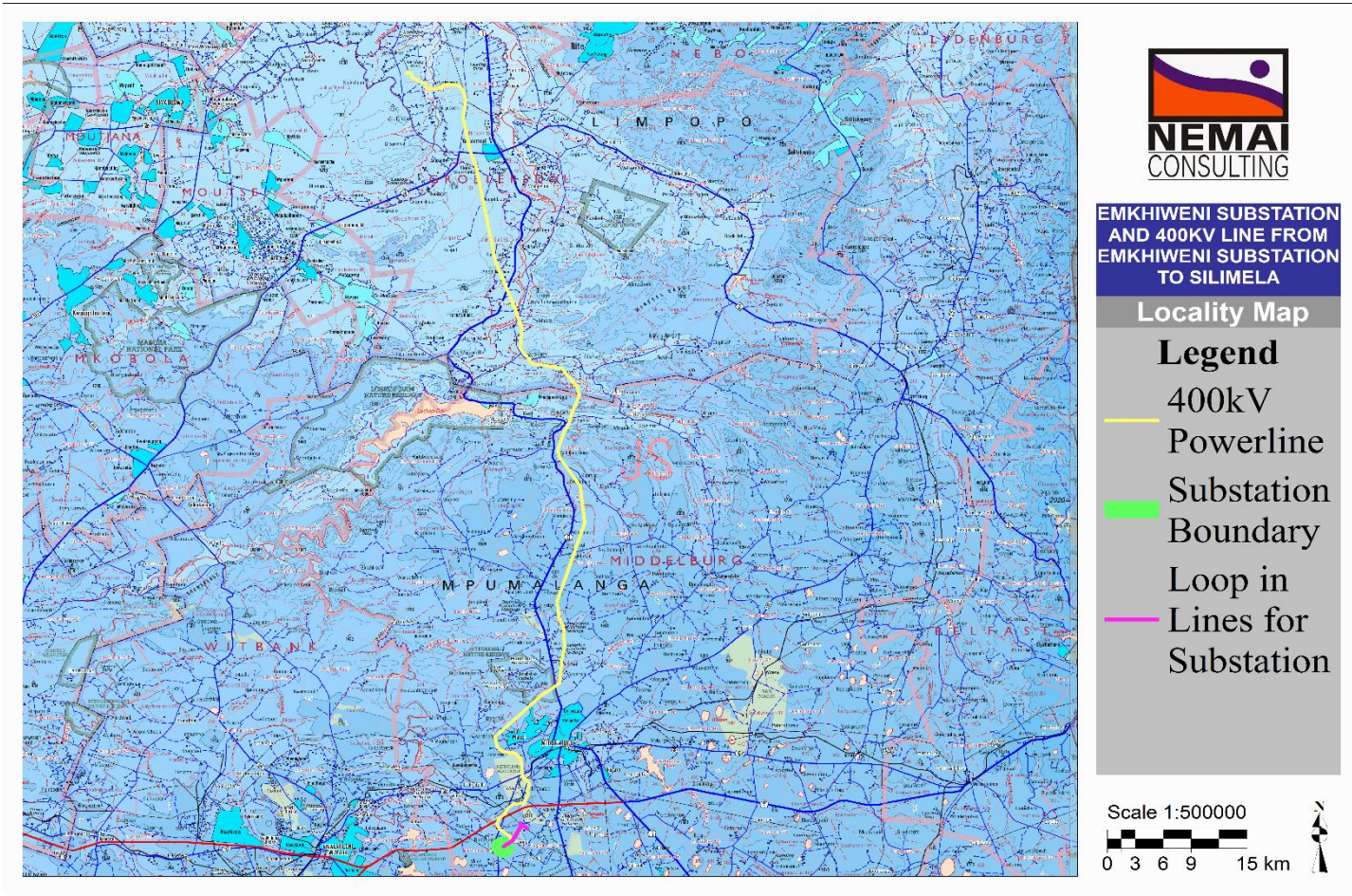


Figure 2: 1:250 000 Topographical map

3 ENVIRONMENTAL LEGAL FRAMEWORK

3.1 Scoping and EIA Process

Eskom Holdings SOC (Pty) Ltd has appointed Nema Consulting as the Independent Environmental Consultant to conduct the Scoping and EIA Process for the proposed Emkhiweni Substation and 400kV Line from Emkhiweni Substation to Silimela.

The proposed project requires environmental authorisation in terms of the EIA Regulations of 2014 (as amended) that were promulgated in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA) from the Competent Authority, i.e. the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA). Activities listed in Government Notice (GN) No. R. 983, GN No. R. 984 and GN No. R. 985 of the 2014 EIA Regulations, as amended (07 April 2017) are associated with the proposed development, which therefore triggers a Scoping and EIA Process.

The Scoping Report will contain details of the assessment conducted and include all comments from IAPs. A draft copy of the Scoping Report will be made available for public review, prior to finalisation and submission to DEA. Only **registered** IAPs will continue to be notified of the Scoping and EIA process.

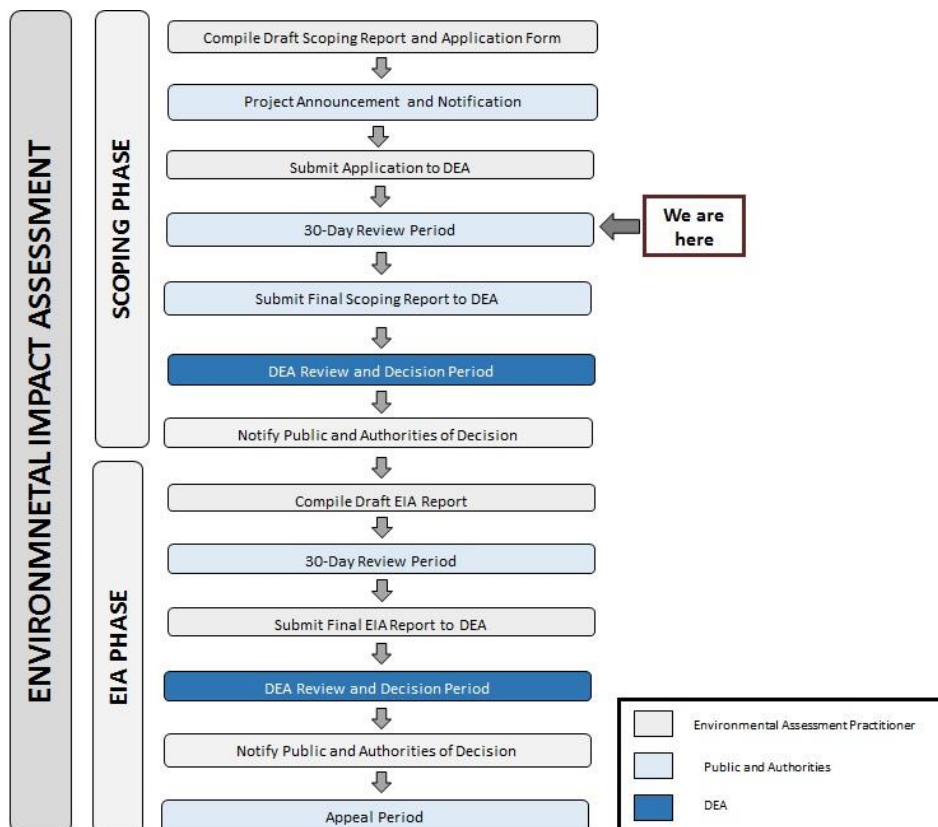


Figure 3: Scoping and EIA Process

4 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Public Participation Process will involve the following:

1. Site notices will be erected at prominent points in and around the study area;
2. BIDs will be distributed to potential IAPs;
3. Notices regarding the project will be e-mailed or faxed to the councillors in the area and possible stakeholders (including authorities and state departments); and
4. Notices will be placed in regional and local newspapers.

IAPs are encouraged to participate in the process in order for concerns to be addressed and included in the Scoping Report. This notice serves to notify all IAPs of the proposed development. IAPs are to review and comment on the draft documents which will be lodged at the following places for review from **16 April 2018 to 17 May 2018:**

COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT SCOPING REPORT FOR PROPOSED EMKHIWENI SUBSTATION AND 400KV LINE FROM EMKHIWENI SUBSTATION TO SILIMELA, MPUMLANGA PROVINCE

The application form and draft Scoping Report (SR) dated April 2018, received by this Department on 13 April 2018 refers.

This Department has the following comments on the abovementioned application:

- **Alternatives**

- Please provide a description of any identified alternatives for the proposed activity that are feasible and reasonable, including the advantages and disadvantages that the proposed activity or alternatives will have on the environment and on the community that may be affected by the activity as per Appendix 2, (2) (1) (h) (i-xi), of GN R.982 of 2014, as amended.
- Alternatively, you should submit written proof of an investigation and motivation if no reasonable or feasible alternatives exist as per the requirements of Appendix 2, (2) (1) (h) (x).
- Please provide coordinates of both the preferred power line route alternative as well as proposed other alternatives route in degrees, minutes and seconds from the start of the activity, midpoint and the end point of the activity.

- **Impacts Assessment**

This Department requests the EAP to familiarise themselves with the requirements of Appendix 2 of GNR 982 of the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) and ensure that the final SR submitted to this Department for consideration meets the requirements in terms of identifying, assessing and providing mitigation measures of the impacts on the alternatives and preferred site.

- **Maps**

- **A3 Layout map**

- A detailed site layout must be prepared incorporating all the alternatives (preferred and other proposed alternatives). It must be attached as Appendix 3 of the final Scoping Report (FSR). The site or route plans must indicate the following:

- the property boundaries and numbers of all the properties within 50 metres of the site;
 - the current land use as well as the land use zoning of the site and the properties adjoining the site;
 - the exact position of each listed activity applied for (including alternatives);
 - a legend explaining the content on the map; and
 - a north arrow.

- It has been noted that the proposed substation and power lines were authorized in 2011, however, the Environmental Authorisation (EA) lapsed. Therefore, you are requested to show the approved route and substation location on the map, taking into consideration areas where there will be deviation from the approved route.

- **A3 Sensitivity Map**

- The layout/route plan as indicated above must be overlain with a sensitivity map that indicates all the sensitive areas associated with the site, including, but not limited to:

- watercourses;
 - the 1:100 year flood line (where available or where it is required by Department of Water and Sanitation : DWS);
 - ridges;
 - cultural and historical features;
 - areas with indigenous vegetation (even if it is degraded or infested with alien species);
 - critical biodiversity areas;
 - build up areas; and
 - No-go areas (if any).

- The sensitivity map must not only overlay the sensitivity of the preferred site, however; must also include all the identified alternatives and the existing infrastructure.

- **Public Participation Process**

- Please ensure that all issues raised and comments received during the circulation of the SR from registered I&APs and organs of state which have jurisdiction (including this Department's Biodiversity Section) in respect of the proposed activity are adequately addressed in the final SR.
 - Proof of correspondence with the various stakeholders must be included in the final SR, should you be unable to obtain comments, proof of the attempts that were made to obtain comments must be submitted to the Department.
 - The Public Participation Process must be conducted in terms of Regulations 39, 40, 41, 42, 43 & 44 of the EIA Regulations 2014, as amended.

- **General Comments**

- You are further reminded that the final SR to be submitted to this Department must comply with all the requirements in terms of the scope of assessment and content of Scoping reports in accordance with Appendix 2 and Regulation 21(1) of the amended EIA Regulations, 2014.

Further note that in terms of Regulation 45 of the EIA Regulations 2014, this application will lapse if the applicant fails to meet any of the timeframes prescribed in terms of the these Regulations, unless an extension has been granted in terms of Regulation 3(7).



COMMENTS ON CONSTRUCTION OF 400KV POWER LINE FROM MIDDLEBURG AREA IN THE SOUTH TO THE MARBLE HALL/WOLWEKRAAL AREA IN THE NORTH, THIRTEEN KILOMETRES TO THE SOUTH-EAST OF MARBLE HALL (LIMPOPO PROVINCE) ON THE FARM LOSKOP NOORD 12 JS, SITUATED IN EPHRAIM MOGALE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY.

This refers to your letter with project number 106743.

The proposed project should adhere to the regulations of Conservation of Agricultural Resources Act 43 of 1983, (CARA) with special attention to the following:

- (1) **Regulation 7 : Utilization and Protection of vleis, marshes, water sponges and water courses.**
 - Except on authority of a written permission by the executive officer, no land user shall:-
 - (a) drain or cultivate any vlei, marsh or water sponge or a portion thereof on his farm unit or
 - (b) cultivate any land on his farm unit within the flood area of a water course or within 10 metres horizontally outside the flood area of a water course.
- (2) **Regulation 8 : Regulating of the flow pattern of run-off water.**
 - No land user shall in any manner whatsoever divert any run-off water from a water course on his farm unit to any other water course, except on authority of a written permission by the executive officer.

The applicant's should also note that **High and medium potential agricultural soils** should be identified and no disturbance on those soils should occur without written permission from this office.

The directorate has no objection against the proposed project on the above mentioned farm provided the above stated conditions and other provisions of the regulations of the Act are adhered to.
