Eskom SOC Ltd has appointed Zitholele Consulting cc to carry out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) in support of an application for Environmental Authorisation for the construction of the Kendal 30 years Ash Disposal Facility, in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014. The project is located in the Emalahleni Local Municipality of Mpumalanga Province and consists of the construction of a conveyor belt; emergency dump and ash return water dams, power lines, water pipelines and access roads. This project aims to extend the existing Kendal Ash disposal by extending the total area of the facility to accommodate more ash dumping. The South African Heritage Resources Agency (SAHRA) previously commented on this proposed development in 2013/06/18, requesting that a Heritage Impact Assessment be conducted for the various options for the facility and conveyor belt route. Subsequently Zitholele Consulting cc appointed PGS Heritage (Pty) Ltd to conduct the HIA and the report has been submitted to the case.

Fourie, W. June 2016. Kendal Power Station 30-year Ash Disposal Facility, Nkangala District Municipality, Mpumalanga. Heritage Impact Assessment.

The author has conducted various surveys on all the proposed options for the Kendal ash disposal facility. Once the preferred Site H was finalised the author conducted a field survey and identified 8 new heritage sites that have previously been unidentified. Seven of the sites are stone packed cemeteries consisting of a total of 149 graves and one heritage site is a farmstead. All of the sites will be directly impacted by the proposed development.

Two Palaeontological Impact Assessments were conducted by Dr G Groenewald in 2013. The Kendal Ash Disposal Facility is underlain by rocks of the Vryheid Formation and the potential impact to Very Highly sensitive palaeontological significant rocks is considered moderate.

The author of the report recommends the following:

Sites (KAD 10; 17; 18; 19; 20; 21), which are cemeteries with the earliest identifiable date being 1901, these cemeteries are all considered to be of high significance. These sites are to be relocated and a full graves relocations process should be conducted and potential relations to the graves be identified, before a permit application to the Burial Grounds and Graves (BGG) Unit is made.

Site KAD 15 is a farmstead which dates to the 1900, with some out buildings, all constructed using stone. The site will be demolished in the construction phase and the site needs to be fully documented, mapped and the plans of the structure recorded along with the history of the surrounding landscape of the farmstead. This will be followed by an application for demolition made to the Mpumalanga Provincial Heritage Authority (MPHRA).

The site KAD 16 is also cemetery with 5 graves identifiable with stone headstones and brick frames. The earliest date of the graves is 1912, and the cemetery is not maintained. The cemetery is fenced and the cemetery also contains a memorial of Dr Albert Hertzog placed there in 1990. This particular grave is rated as grade 3B.

If the Vryheid Formation will be exposed and impacted during construction of the Ash Disposal Facility then a qualified professional palaeontologist needs to be hired as part of the Environmental Construction Team. His responsibilities as a palaeontologist is to obtain a mitigation permit from SAHRA and monitor the ground clearance and deep excavations during the excavation phases, for any fossils that may be uncovered. He/she will compile a phase 2 report to be submitted to SAHRA after the construction phase detailing the finds (if any).

Final Comment

SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit accepts the HIA as is, and agrees with the recommendations provided in the report. As such SAHRA has no objections to the proposed Kendal 30 year Ash Disposal Facility being constructed on the following conditions:

A letter of appointment for the palaeontologist must be submitted to the case in the case private field. The letter must also indicate the days in which he/she will be on site for monitoring.

The graves must be mitigated in terms of section 36 of the NHRA as mentioned in the recommendations of the report.

You may contact SAHRA APM Unit for further details: (Nokukhanya Khumalo/John Gribble 021 202 8652). If any unmarked human burials are uncovered then please contact the SAHRA BGG Unit (Itumeleng Masiteng/Mimi Seetelo 012 320 8490). A professional archaeologist or palaeontologist, depending on the nature of the finds, must be contracted as soon as possible to inspect the findings at the expense of the developer. If the newly discovered heritage resources prove to be of archaeological or palaeontological significance, a Phase 2 rescue operation may be required at the expense of the developer.

The above conditions should be included into the EMPr for the project for implementation during construction, operation and decommissioning of the facility.

This project covers a large area of agricultural importance, therefore the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries view it as a challenge which should be tackled through faces as to minimize damage.

Current land use

The land parcels in question are currently used for intensive cultivation practices. These practices are consistent with the surrounding land uses of the area. Mostly planted are annual crops. It is unknown if irrigation practices are applied to all cultivated fields but the presence of centre pivots on some of the land parcels is acknowledged.

Land capability

The Land Capability Classification for the areas concerned mainly consists of Class III and that indicates moderate potential agricultural land.

It may have some limitations that can reduce the choice of plants or that may require moderate conservation practices. However it has the capability to be used for cultivation, with few limitations and with practices that are easy to apply.

Grazing capacity

According to the 1993 grazing capacity these farms have the grazing capacity of 3Ha/LUSM making the areas highly suited for grazing purposes. However due to the cultivation practices very limited natural veld has remained for this purpose

The construction phases of this project can be used to minimize damage if well followed.

A. CONSTRUCTION PHASE

Site Clearing

- Site clearing should take place in a phased matter, as and when required. Areas which are not be affected by construction should not be cleared as to reduce erosion risk. The area to be cleared should be demarcated and strictly maintained.
- Erosion control measures should be implemented in areas where these risks are more prevalent.
- Topsoil removed should be neatly stockpiled in stockpiles of not higher than 1.5 m adjacent to the excavations ready for backfill when required.
- Minimizes the impact on vegetation outside the immediate areas of the work.
- In sensitive environments, proper perimeter fence should be erected around the work area. Signs should also be erected to indicate no go zone areas.
- No activity allowed which will affect the quality of the environment.
- Maintain site demarcations in positions until completion of construction works.

Soil impacts

❖ Topsoil

- The full depth of top soil should be stripped from areas affected by construction and related activities prior to commencement of major earthworks.
- Care should be taken not to mix topsoil and subsoil during stripping
- Polluted soil should be disposed of at licensed landfill site.

❖ Soil stripping

- No soil stripping should take place on areas within the site that the constructor does not require for construction work.
- Subsoil and overburden should be stockpiled separately to be returned for backfilling in the correct soil horizon order

❖ Stockpiles

- Stockpiles should not be positioned in such a way that they will obstruct natural water way and drainage channels.
- If stockpiles are exposed to heavy rain, they should be covered by impermeable material to prevent soil loss.
- Stockpiles should be further protected by building beams around their bases.
- Stockpiles should be kept clear of weeds and alien vegetation.

❖ Fuel storage

- Topsoil and subsoil to be protected from contamination
- Fuel and material storage should be away from stockpiles.
- Contaminated soil should be contained and disposed of at an approved landfill site

❖ Erosion

- Storm water control should be undertaken to prevent soil loss from site.
- All erosion control measures need to be regularly maintained.

- Retention of vegetation where possible.
- Re-vegetation of disturbed areas and surfaces should occur immediately after the construction activities are completed.

B. CONSTRUCTION PHASE

Erosion control

- Loss of topsoil should be minimized.
- Erosion and subsequent siltation must be limited.
- Drainage channels should be suitably maintained to ensure that erosion does not occur.
- All areas susceptible to erosion should be protected and stabilization measures implemented.

C. REHABILITATION PHASE


Rehabilitation

- Stripping and replacing or stripping and stockpiling of soil has a severe deteriorating impact on land capability and soil potential even if proper and precise rehabilitation procedures are followed because the natural horizon sequences and natural balanced processes in the soil profile are disturbed and cannot be reconstructed.
- The rehabilitation process which include shaping of spoil surfaces and stripping and replacing of topsoil should be monitored continuously by a competent third party. The rehabilitation should be documented as a future reference.
- This will be the only way to ensure that rehabilitation of high standards take place.

Recommendation.

The Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries supports this project and also reserves the right to altered or amend its viewpoint based on forthcoming studies, documentation and information which may become available as the process progresses.
