As per your correspondence, you are notifying this Department of the submission of final basic assessment report, inclusive of specialist reports and EMPr within 140 days, due to the City of Cape Town (one of the local commenting authorities) requested the completion of Traffic Impact Statement (TIS), which must be included in the final BAR. Should you then decide to further pursue the application after closure of the file, a new application for environmental authorisation in terms of the EIA Regulations, 2014, must be submitted to this Department prior to the commencement of such activity (ies).

You are hereby reminded of Section 24F of the National Environmental Management Act, Act No 107 of 1998, as amended, that no activity may commence prior to an environmental authorisation being granted by the Department.
