One of our conservancy members, Mr Lammie Louw of the farm Tweekuil in the Malmesbury district has asked me to contact you regarding the above matter. Proposed powerlines are planned to go over his land.

Mr Nelius Louw of the farm Rondomsrik has not received notice concerning the above proposed powerlines even though the proposed siteB for a substation is planned for his farm.

Can we receive more information as to exactly how big these substations and powerlines are going to be - show us examples of similar substations and powerlines.

Another big query from our members is how much arable land is going to be lost to the farmers due to powerlines going over farmland. Existing powerlines over farmland make it already very difficult cultivating the land.

is it possible for landowners to suggest alternative routes for the proposed powerlines?

From the conservancy point of view it is worrying that Eskom is exempt from appointing an independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner as required by the the National Environmental Management Act where such powerlines are planned to go over farms who have joined a conservancy.

The other worrying fact is that these powerlines are planned at a huge financial cost to Eskom for the pure reason that the dairy at Vyevlei (the biggest dairy in the western cape) requires more electricity when the technology exists for Eskom to use the dairy to generate power for the dairy and enough additional electricity to service the whole of Malmesbury if not more.
